The United States Attorney charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about August 24, 2022, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, and elsewhere, the defendant, **COLBI TRENT DEFIORE**, did, by means of interstate commerce, knowingly attempt to transfer obscene matter to another individual who had not attained the age of 16 years, knowing that the other individual had not attained the age of 16 years, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1470.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegations of Count 1 of this Bill of Information are incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 1, defendant, **COLBI TRENT DEFIORE**, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 1467, any interest in:


- a. any obscene material produced, transported, mailed, shipped, or received in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 71;
- b. any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offense; and
- c. any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of the offense.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred, sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
