

January 9, 2023 Status Update – Ascertainment of Counsel Hearing

We write to provide you with an update on our efforts to prosecute Abu Agila Mohammad Mas'ud Kheir al-Marimi for his alleged role in the attack on your loved ones in the bombing of Pan Am 103.

The Ascertainment of Counsel Hearing that was scheduled for January 10, 2023 at 2:00 pm (ET) has been continued until January 25, 2023 at 2:00 pm (ET). The first purpose of the hearing is to determine whether the defendant has retained private counsel or will be appointed counsel by the Court. Second, if the defendant has retained counsel or been appointed counsel to represent him, the court will conduct an Arraignment, at which the defendant will enter a plea to the charges filed in this case. The government expects the defendant to enter a plea of not guilty at this hearing. Your attendance is not required. The hearing will take place at the E. Barrett Prettyman Courthouse, 333 Constitution, Ave., NW, Washington, DC 20001, in courtroom 7, on the second floor.
