ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 7, 2023, Complainant, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, and Respondent, Satguru Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a 7-Eleven Store #29718, d/b/a 7-Eleven Store #15558, d/b/a 7-Eleven Store #32414, filed a Notice of Settlement and Joint Motion to Dismiss in the above-captioned matter. The parties inform the Court that they have reached a full settlement and agree to dismiss this action without prejudice.

Pursuant to 28 C.F.R. § 68.14(a)(2), where parties have entered into a settlement agreement, they shall "[n]otify the Administrative Law Judge that the parties have reached a full settlement and have agreed to dismissal of the action. Dismissal of the action shall be subject to the approval of the Administrative Law Judge, who may require the filing of the settlement agreement." After reviewing the Notice of Settlement and Joint Motion to Dismiss, the Court finds that dismissal is appropriate. Accordingly, the Joint Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED.

Therefore, IT IS SO ORDERED that the case brought by Complainant, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, against Respondent, Satguru Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a 7-Eleven Store #29718, d/b/a 7-Eleven Store #32414, OCAHO Case No. 2022A00030, is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
