FACTUAL BASIS

Were this matter brought to trial, the United States would prove, through competent evidence, the following beyond a reasonable doubt.

On or about May 7, 2015, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Department of Homeland Security (DHS) agents were notified that the defendant **CARLOS RAMIREZ-VASQUEZ** (**RAMIREZ-VASQUEZ**) had been arrested by Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office in the Eastern District of Louisiana. **RAMIREZ-VASQUEZ** admitted to agents that he was a Mexican citizen without immigration documents that would permit him to be in the United States.

Records checks revealed that **RAMIREZ-VASQUEZ** is, in fact, a citizen of Mexico illegally present in the United States and that he had been deported on April 17, 2000.


Since his deportations, **RAMIREZ-VASQUEZ** did not receive the requisite consent from the U.S. Attorney General or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, to apply for readmission or receive permission to reenter the United States.
