Electronic Networking of Medical Examiner and Coroner Offices in the United States

Recommendation

The National Commission on Forensic Science requests that the Attorney General of the United States approve policy that recommends the implementation of an electronic communication network for all medical examiner and coroner offices in the United States, to be developed and implemented by 2017 in conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and other federal agencies with interest in medicolegal death investigation.

Recommended Implementation Strategy

The National Institute of Justice and CDC would establish and fund a Working Group in 2015 to prepare a specific plan to develop a Medical Examiner and Coroner Electronic Information Network (MECIN).

The working group would include at least one representative from each of the following, including a sufficient number of members from the medical examiner and coroner communities:

- National Association of Medical Examiners
- International Association of Coroners and Medical Examiners
- The National Institute of Justice

Features and Functions

- Controlled dissemination of information
- Controlled responses to user inquiries
- A repository for important documents
- Announcements of grant and funding opportunities
- Facilitation of research
- Controlled access to an ME/C Directory
- Accessibility to all ME/Cs
- Controlled access to the system
- User registration, verification, and updating
- A stable, permanent email address system

The email addresses would be permanent on not change if the individual coroner or ME changes.



Working Group Duties

- Review/Refine system goals
- Modify working group membership if needed
- Identify a parent entity to administer/manage the system
- Develop a plan to ensure internet and email access for all ME/Cs
- Determine how information would be controlled and disseminated
- Identify initial and ongoing funding and support sources
- Plan so that federal restrictions on communication are not an obstacle to system utility
