INFORMATION

The Acting United States Attorney charges that:

MISBRANDING OF A DRUG WHILE HELD FOR SALE (21 U.S.C. §§ 331(k) and 333(a)(1))

On or about January 22, 2015, in Broward County, in the Southern District of Florida, and elsewhere, the defendant,

MICHAEL SHANE MATTHEWS,

caused to be dispensed the prescription drug Flurbiprofen without the prescription of a practitioner licensed by law to administer the drug, while the drug was held for sale and after the drug had been shipped in interstate commerce, which act resulted in the drug being misbranded within the meaning of Title 21, United States Code, Section 353(b)(1).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 331(k) and 333(a)(1), and United States Code, Section 2.

FORFEITURE (21 U.S.C. §334)

- 1. The allegations of this Information are re-alleged and incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of certain property in which the defendant, **MICHAEL SHANE MATTHEWS**, has an interest.
- 2. Upon conviction of a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 331, as alleged in this Information, the defendant shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(7), among other things, property, real or personal, that constitutes, or is derived, directly or indirectly, from gross proceeds traceable to such violation.
- 3. Upon conviction of a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 331 or 333, as alleged in this Information, the defendant, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 334, any quantities of Flurbiprofen which were misbranded when introduced into interstate commerce or while in interstate commerce, or while held for sale (whether or not the first sale) after shipment in interstate commerce, or which were introduced into interstate commerce in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 331.
- 4. The property which is subject to criminal forfeiture includes, but is not limited to, the following: \$439,765 which is a sum of money equal in value to the property that constitutes, or is derived, directly or indirectly, from gross proceeds traceable the violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 331, as alleged in this Information, and which the United States will seek as a forfeiture money judgment against the defendant as part of his sentence.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(7), Title 21, United States Code, Section 334, as made applicable by Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and the procedures of Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, as made applicable by Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(b)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
