#### THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

### COUNT 1

### (Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Substance)

That on or about May 19, 2016, in the Southern District of Iowa, defendant SHAWNE MARIE WIDENER, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, with said controlled substance being oxycodone and hydrocodone, Schedule II controlled substances.

This is a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

#### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES:

## **COUNT 2**(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Substance)

That on or about December 12, 2016, in the Southern District of Iowa, defendant SHAWNE MARIE WIDENER, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, with said controlled substance being oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance.

This is a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

#### THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES:

# **COUNT 3** (Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Substance)

That on or about January 12, 2017, in the Southern District of Iowa, defendant SHAWNE MARIE WIDENER, did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, with said controlled substance being oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance.

This is a violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.
