Having reviewed the parties' pre-motion letters, <u>see</u> ECF Nos.

At that time, if no amended complaint has been filed, the parties should confer on a briefing schedule agreeable to both sides, in which no more than sixty (60) days elapse from the filing of the defendants' motion to the filing of the defendants' reply.
