- Subcommittee already reviewed draft questions
- Will survey offices with <100 officers, 100-249, 500-999, >1000 officers
- Will ask what forensic services they provide, where they send evidence if not done in-house (other state or local agency, commercial laboratory), medical examiner or coroner office?

- Will query #employees, accreditation, certification?
- Will try to group questions by appropriate respondent (investigator, scientist, chief)
- Subcommittee pleased with breadth & depth of questions, & wanted to ensure that we don't ask questions that are too difficult to answer- like when did they 1st get accredited- just are they currently accredited

- Collect data on current staff numbers, positions & duties
- Attempting to collect as much data as possible on medical examiner & coroner offices
- Replaced "criminalists" with forensic scientists
- Set a low threshold on amount of time a person needed to be designated as "forensic" to be included
- Ensure definitions approved by the Commission are included throughout the document

- Examples of forensic science services include:
 - Crime scene
 - Identification examinations
 - Document examinations
 - Firearms/ballistics examinations
 - Toolmark examinations
 - Digital & multimedia examinations
 - Drug or chemical identifications
 - Biological or toxicological examinations
 - Trace evidence examinations
