#### REPORT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FOREIGN AGENTS REGISTRATION ACT OF 1938, AS AMENDED FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1963

## TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act which requires the Attorney General from time to time to report to the Congress concerning the administration of the Act, as well as the nature, source and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed by agents of foreign principals registered under the Act.

It has been the policy of the Department since 1950 to prepare a report each year and this report deals with the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act for the calendar year 1963.



In view of the increasing interest of Members of Congress, various departments and agencies of the Executive Branch, the press and the public in the identity and activity of persons and organizations acting within the United States as agents of foreign interests and foreign governments, arrangements have been made for this Report to be made available through the Superintendent of Documents.

#### STATISTICAL SUMMARY

In 1963, 87 new registration statements were filed and an equal number of registrations were terminated leaving 419 active registrations on file as of December 31, 1963. Appendix II contains an alphabetical list of registrants who filed statements in 1963, together with the name of the foreign principal and a brief description of the nature of the agency relationship while Appendix I contains a list of these statements according to registration number. Appendix III lists all registrations which were in an active status as of December 31, 1963, indexed according to the geographical area or nationality field of their foreign principal.

During the calendar year, 535 short-form registration statements were filed by partners, officers,

directors, or other persons rendering assistance to registrants for or in the interests of the foreign principals. The individuals filing short-form registration statements are listed in alphabetical order in Appendix IV. The identity of the registrant in support of whose statement the short-form registration statement was filed may be ascertained by consulting Appendix I in correlation with the registration number.

During 1963, the Registration Section received 314 amendments to the registration statements on file. This figure represents more than twice the number of 144 received in 1962 and reflects the Registration Section's continued emphasis on the review of all supplemental statements as they are filed to insure compliance with the requirements of the Act. The Registration Section processed and reviewed 705 supplemental registration statements and answered over 3,000 pieces of correspondence from other government agencies, prospective registrants, registrants, and the general public.

As in the past the largest number of new registration statements was filed by persons engaging in publicity, public relations, advertising or allied fields. The second largest category was attorneys and

the third largest group included persons retained as economic consultants, financial advisers and trade promoters. A table showing the classification of statements according to the character of the agent's activity will be found in Appendix V.

With regard to the new registrations, it was noted that 33 of the new registrants represented foreign principals in Latin America and that of this particular group eleven represented principals in the Dominican Republic.

#### ENFORCEMENT

Although registrations are generally effected through voluntary compliance with the Act, two prosecutions for violations of the Act were initiated and successfully concluded during the year. Early in January, 1963, the United States District Court for the District of Columbia impaneled, at the Department's request, a Special Grand Jury to investigate possible violations of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. During the term of the Grand Jury several matters were considered, resulting in the return of two indictments.

A four count indictment was returned in the District of Columbia on February 8, 1963 charging Igor Cassini, syndicated New York society columnist, with

failure to register under the Act as an agent for the Trujillo Government of the Dominican Republic. Also named in two counts of the indictment was R. Paul Englander, an attorney from New York City. The defendants were charged with acting within the United States as agents of the Trujillo Government of the Dominican Republic in that they had, inter alia, conducted a public relations program on behalf of the Dominican Republic in return for approximately \$150,000 without having registered under the Act. In addition to the unlawful and wilful failure to register, the defendants were charged with conspiracy to violate the Act. On July 8, 1963 a bid by defense attorneys to win dismissal of the indictment was rejected and a motion for a change of venue to New York City was also denied.

On October 8, 1963 Cassini entered pleas of nolo contendere to each of four counts of the indictment and Englander entered a similar plea to the first count of the indictment charging the substantive violation of

failure to register. On January 10, 1964 Cassini was fined \$10,000 on Count 1 and on Counts 2, 3, and 4 imposition of sentence was suspended and Cassini was placed on probation for six months. Imposition of sentence on Count 1 was suspended as to Englander and he was also placed on probation for six months and fined \$10,000.

The second indictment was returned on April 17, 1963, against Dr. Elmer Henry Loughlin, an American physician residing in Haiti, charging him with failure to register under the Act as an agent of the Government of Haiti, its officers, agents and representatives. On December 16, 1963, at the time of trial the defendant entered a plea of <u>nolo contendere</u>. The defendant was subsequently sentenced on January 10, 1964, receiving a suspended sentence of one to four years with probation for a period of four years.

The case of <u>Victor Rabinowitz and Leonard B.</u> <u>Boudin v. The Attorney General of the United States is</u> now pending in the United States Supreme Court. As previously reported, Victor Rabinowitz and Leonard Boudin filed a complaint on November 15, 1961, seeking a declaratory judgment that their activities as legal representatives of the Revolutionary Government of Cuba

did not require their registration under the Act. The gist of this action was to restrain the Attorney General from prosecuting Rabinowitz and Boudin for failure to comply with the provisions of the Act. An appeal was entered on May 15, 1962, from an interlocutory order of the District Court denying the Government's motion for judgment on the pleadings. Bubsequently, the Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia in finding that neither the constitutionality of the Act nor the Attorney General's authority to enforce it was being challenged ordered that the suit be dismissed on the pleadings as an unconsented suit against the United States. The complainants petitioned the Supreme Court of the United States for a writ of certiorari, which writ was granted on October 14, 1963.  $\frac{1}{}$ 

Another aspect of the Registration Section's enforcement program in 1963 was the furnishing of copies of the Report to Congress for calendar year 1962 to the Department of State for distribution to its nationality desk officers and to its overseas posts for review and

comments. Considerable information was made available to the Registration Section under this program resulting not only in the initiation of investigations into possible violations of the Act, but also in a few instances in the filing of registration statements.

During the past year the Registration Section at the suggestion of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee initiated a program for the dissemination to the interested departments and agencies of the Federal Government and certain Congressional committees of copies of the statements received by the Section. Favorable comments on this program by the participating agencies have warranted its continuation.

#### LEGISLATION

The study initiated in July 1962 by the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations of activities of nondiplomatic representatives of foreign principals in the United States was concluded in November 1963. As a result of this investigation Senators J. W. Fulbright and Bourke B. Hickenlooper introduced S. 2136 which would give the Department additional authority for effecting compliance with the disclosure provisions of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. A companion Bill, H.R. 9212, has been introduced in the House by Representative Celler.

#### NATURE, SOURCE AND CONTENT OF POLITICAL PROPAGANDA

In order to analyze more effectively the political propaganda disseminated within the United States, and as an additional step in its increased emphasis on enforcement of the labeling and filing provisions of the Act, the Registration Section in July 1963 employed a professional political analyst. The 16,000 pieces of political propaganda which were filed with the Registration Section in 1963 were examined for the purpose of determining whether the material was properly labeled in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the propaganda trends Filed with the propaganda were 4,658 disanalyzed. semination reports. These reports reflect the nature of the publication, how and by whom it was disseminated, as well as the quantity and to whom it was transmitted.

Official foreign government information and tourist offices, in furtherance of their efforts to create good will toward their respective countries and to present to the American public their positions with respect to matters of international importance, continue to constitute the greatest source of propaganda in the United States. As of December 31, 1963, there were 69

foreign government information and tourist offices functioning within the United States representing 36 different countries. Expenditures in an amount exceeding eleven million dollars have been reported by such registrants as of the end of 1963. Appendix VI contains financial data setting forth the expenditures of official foreign government information and tourist offices within the United States as reported for the year 1963.

As stated previously, many foreign countries continue to rely upon American public relations concerns and consultants for advice concerning the nature and content of the propaganda material to be circulated to the American public. This is reflected in the large number of public relations firms, consultants, and advisers which are registered under the Act. Appendix VII contains a summary showing the amount of money received by American individuals and organizations from their foreign principals during the calendar year covered by the report. Included in this list are the names of American public relations advisers and consultants who have been retained by foreign governments during the period.

Following is an analysis of the principal trends noted during 1963 in the propaganda material disseminated on behalf of the countries and geographical areas listed below:

#### ARAB STATES

The Arab Information Center distributed a variety of informational material on behalf of the League of Arab States which includes the Governments of Algeria, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia, the United Arab Republic and Yemen. "For the Record", a special report issued at random intervals, deals with such political subjects as Arab-Israeli relations, the Arab Boycott, and atomic research in the United Arab Republic. A major theme of this publication is that Israeli propaganda is a camouflage for aggressive designs on Arab territory and a threat to Arab-American relations. The Arab propaganda expresses the hope that the United States will not abandon its policy of "impartial neutrality" in the area and choose Israel as its favored state in the Middle East.

A monthly newsletter, "Arab News and Views", is mainly concerned with subjects of a political nature

but carries some articles on economic and cultural topics. Much attention is given to the various efforts to achieve political and economic unity among the Arab countries.

The Arab Information Center also disseminates a monthly magazine, "The Arab World", which treats a wide variety of social, economic and political subjects and offers special articles on the development and achievements of member states of the League. The balance of Arab propaganda distributed by the Center consists of press releases, information papers and special reports containing background information on the history, cultural and economic development of the various League members.

The Palestine Arab Delegation, which represents the Arab Higher Committee for Palestine, also distributes propaganda favorable to the Arab states. The central interest of the Delegation is the repatriation and compensation of Arab refugees by Israel, and the protection of the rights of Arabs now living in Israel.

#### BRITISH GUIANA

The British Guiana Public Relations and Information Office in New York disseminates news releases which explain that Government's position on various political issues.

During 1963, attention was centered upon the drive for independence from Great Britain. The Government, under Premier Cheddi Jagan, expressed its opposition to the proposals of the opposition parties for the establishment of a system of proportional representation and the holding of elections before independence is granted. The Government explained that considering the multi-racial and multi-religious composition of British Guiana, a system of proportional representation would only lead to a multiplicity of parties, and general governmental instability. On the issue of holding elections before the granting of independence, the government publications said that such had not been the practice of Britain when independence had been granted other territories. A number of articles were concerned with counteracting the charges of the opposition parties that there is discrimination in the public service, that Russia and Cuba are subverting British Guiana, and that

there is serious racial animosity and division in the country.

The Peoples National Congress (PNC), the major opposition party in British Guiana, maintains a Help Guiana Committee in New York which distributes a fortnightly publication, "PNC Overseas News Letter", and press releases. This material is primarily concerned with criticizing the activities of the Government and the majority Peoples' Progressive Party (PPP). In a reported speech to the British Guiana legislative assembly, the leader of the PNC, Forbes Burnham, said that since the PPP had refused to accept a system of proportional representation, the voters should be allowed to decide in a referendum which electoral system the country should have. He added that the people should also make the final decision on the question of independence. On other issues, the newsletter voiced opposition to the Government's new budget and the Premier's "unrealistic policy" of becoming involved in a power struggle between East and West.

#### GHANA

The Government of Ghana makes known its views on a variety of subjects through the official Ghana

Information Services, located in New York. A recurrent theme of the news releases and magazine, "Ghana Today", distributed by this office concerns the need for a continental African political union. President Nkrumah often referred to this subject in his speeches, saying that such a political union was necessary for orderly progress, for presenting a united front, and for the eventual freeing of those African states which have not yet achieved independence. On specific African issues, the Ghana propaganda expressed the Government's opposition to the policies of Portugal, Southern Rhodesia, South Africa and secessionist Katanga, and presented proposals for replacing UN forces in the Congo with all-African troops. The Government publications purported to maintain an impartial posture toward the non-African world. References to "capitalists" and "neocolonialists" as "subversive" influences increased during the year.

#### Great Britain

As in previous years, the British Information Services continued to disseminate the bulk of British propaganda in the United States. Included in the material distributed are "Today's British Papers", daily summaries of British press commentaries on current events, "The British Record", a newsletter of political and economic notes, biographies of government officials, reprints of speeches, "Factels" relating to the British possessions and general news releases.

During the year, the major issues treated in the British publications included the failure of the Common Market negotiations, the signing of the test ban treaty, and the process and problems of granting independence to British possessions. In regard to the failure of the Common Market negotiations, the British publications expressed hope for the eventual achievement of an "outward-looking, united Europe", gave new emphasis to the European Free Trade Association of which Britain is a member, and appealed to the United States for more investment and closer cooperation in the economic sphere. On the issue of Malaysia, the British publications expressed the Government's conviction that the new State should be a success considering the common elements shared by its members and depending upon the will of the people. It is Britain's desire, the publications reported, to lead its colonies to independence, but the Government wants to be certain that each

territory can stand on its own before granting independence.

#### INDIA

The Information Service of the Indian Embassy disseminates two regular publications, a daily bulletin entitled "Indiagram" and a weekly newspaper, "Weekly India News". During 1963, the main theme of these publications continued to be India's border disputes with China and Pakistan.

In regard to China, the Indian publications repeatedly state the willingness of the Government to hold talks with the Chinese Government if the latter will accept the Colombo proposals <u>in toto</u>. In the meantime, Prime Minister Nehru is quoted as saying that the country will add to its defenses, as India will not yield to force or aggression.

During 1963, the dispute with Pakistan over Kashmir intensified, with reports being published that Pakistan, too, was engaged in an arms buildup on India's border. India's delegate to the United Nations, Mrs. Pandit, is quoted as saying that no further concessions would be made to Pakistan. She charged that only when aggression failed in Kashmir did Pakistan become a champion of self-determination and stated that the solicitude of Pakistan for the self-determination of Kashmiris might be better appreciated had some measure of self-determination been extended by Pakistan to the territories under its own control.

On the new relationship between Pakistan and China which developed during the year, the Indian publications state that the two countries have nothing in common except hatred for and distrust of India.

#### INDONESIA

The Government of Indonesia utilizes the Information Office of its Embassy in Washington for the distribution of news releases and a magazine, "Report on Indonesia", which seeks to clarify the Government's position on various political issues. By late summer of 1963, the Malaysian issue had become a predominant theme of these publications. Government officials were quoted as saying that opposition to Malaysia was based on Indonesia's determination to eradicate all colonialism and imperialism in the area. These officials further state that Indonesia would not initiate an armed clash but was ready to defend the country with all available resources. They claimed that the breaking off of trade with Malaysia and Singapore had not caused great economic hardship but rather allowed Indonesia to establish foundations for further development of the national economy.

On the subject of the pre-existing economic crisis, the Government publications carried statements by President Sukarno and other Government officials expressing confidence that the country would be able to overcome the present difficulties within a year or two. The hope was also expressed that the United Nations would assume a far larger role in providing assistance in development following the cuts in aid by the United States Congress.

#### ISRAEL

The Jewish Agency-American Section, Inc., an agent of the Jewish Agency for Israel in Jerusalem, conducts a program designed to promote a favorable image of Israel and Zionism, and to encourage support of the immigration and resettlement programs of the Jewish Agency in Israel. In the course of these activities, the American Section disseminates a fortnightly newsletter, "The Israel Digest of Press and Events in Israel and the Middle East", which treats a wide variety

of subjects including the foreign and domestic policies of the Israel Government, the religious and cultural life of the country, economic and scientific developments, and the immigration programs of the Agency itself. The American Section also distributes press releases, booklets and other material of an occasional nature which deal with these same topics.

The official Israel Information Services, formerly known as the Israel Office of Information, distributes a bi-weekly newsletter, "News from Israel", which contains short reports of political, economic and cultural news, and occasional booklets consisting of reprints of speeches on Israeli foreign relations. These publications and those distributed by the American Section stress the continuing crucial nature of Israel-Arab relations, and Israel's determination to remain firm and militarily strong while pressing for direct negotiations on mutual problems.

#### JAPAN

The United States-Japan Trade Council, a nonprofit association of business firms sponsored in part by the Japan Trade Promotion Office, distributes informational material to Congressmen, economists and business editors concerning the promotion of trade relations between the United States and Japan.

During 1963, the Council issued statements opposing the Buy-American policies of the Defense Department saying that actions under this program would not have a substantial effect upon the United States balance of payments. Reports on Japanese trade liberalization and expanding Japanese agricultural markets conclude with the reminder that the dollar benefits of export increases can be enjoyed as long as Japanese products are allowed freedom to compete in the American market and earn foreign exchange. The Council reported that during 1962 the total trade between the United States and Japan was slightly in excess of \$2.75 billion, with the United States enjoying a favorable trade balance of a little over \$50 million.

The Japan Trade Center, an office of the Japan External Trade Organization, distributes specific information on Japanese products and their sources.

#### KOREA

The Information Office of the Korean Embassy in Washington distributed a magazine entitled "Korean Report" which carries political news and occasional articles about the social and cultural aspects of Korean life. During 1963, the "Report" reflected the lingering internal political crisis which accompanied the Government's efforts to transfer political control to civilian hands. Assurances were given that delays in the transfer were due to the desire of the military government to insure a stable political environment and free elections.

Another prominent theme of this propaganda concerned the division of Korea and the Communist regime in the North. The Government publication affirmed support of the United Nations as the agency responsible for settling the Korean division issue, and stated that no true peace was possible until the country was again united. Other articles discredit the North Korean Communist regime, emphasizing its subservience to a foreign power and its continuing employment of coercion and subversion. Attention is also given to the Government Reconstruction program and economic reforms which are aimed at establishing major industries and promoting free competition.

#### PAKISTAN

The Information Division of the Embassy of Pakistan disseminates a semi-monthly news bulletin, "Pakistan Affairs", and occasional press reprints.

The dispute with India over Kashmir continued to be the major issue in Pakistani foreign affairs, according to the Embassy's news bulletin. On the occasion of Pakistan's 16th anniversary of independence, the publication reported that President Ayub had appealed to Indian "reason and good sense" to resolve the dispute, saying that peaceful settlement was in the self-interest of both countries. He warned, however, that India had been receiving large quantities of weapons, and since serious war between India and China was out of the question because of the physical barriers of the Himalayas, there was fear that such a highly armed country might overrun its smaller and weaker neighbors. Throughout the year, the Pakistani literature repeated the Government's argument for a plebiscite on Kashmir, and also its willingness to settle the dispute in accordance with the United Nations resolutions or other peaceful means. The agreement giving aircraft

landing rights to Red China on Pakistani soil was announced in a small article.

The Pakistani literature also emphasized economic news, particularly the progress of the country's third Five Year Plan. The Foreign Minister was quoted as saying that Pakistan would like to end the arms race with India so that she could devote all her resources to raising the country's standard of living.

#### PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

China Books and Periodicals, Imported Publications and Products, and World Books are the major outlets for Chinese propaganda in this country. The publications distributed included a monthly magazine, "China Reconstructs", a weekly news magazine, "Peking Review", a magazine entitled "China Pictoral", a magazine for young people entitled "Evergreen", various booklets dealing with political topics, and politically orientated novels.

During 1963, the Sino-Soviet ideological dispute became an open and major topic of discussion by the parties involved. The differences between the two countries were blamed in part on the "meddling" of the United States. One article said that the pivotal

point of the Kennedy Administration's foreign policy was to sow discord between China and the Soviet Union and undermine the socialist camp. The "Indian reactionaries" were also charged with exploiting the Sino-Soviet differences and thereby playing into the hands of the U.S. imperialists. After the talks between the Russians and the Chinese in Moscow during July, Red China's propaganda attacks on the Soviet Union became more frequent and bitter. The Soviet Union was charged with allying itself with United States imperialism, openly betraying Marxist Leninism and proletarian internationalism. The Soviet Union was criticized for its methods of spreading the socialist revolution, for placing and later withdrawing the missiles from Cuba, and in general, for pursuing a revisionist course which allegedly was begun in 1956. During the year, increasing emphasis was placed on the need for Chinese selfreliance and for independent national economic construction.

On the issue of the nuclear test ban treaty, the Chinese accused the Soviet Union of capitulating to United States imperialism and of betraying the Russian people. Objections to the treaty were based on the

fact that it did not provide for the complete prohibition and destruction of nuclear weapons, and that the non-nuclear countries did not play any role in its formulation. The Chinese publications repeatedly called for a conference of all countries on the subject of banning nuclear weapons. The treaty was also criticized for creating an illusion of peace and of lulling the vigilance of the people of the world.

Considerable attention was given to the border dispute with India. In denying any military buildup on the border, the Chinese charged the Indians with rumor-mongering in order to divert world attention from their own political bankruptcy and crisis at home.

#### U.S.S.R.

Imported Publications and Products, Four Continent Book Corporation, and Crosscurrents Press are the principal agents for the distribution of Soviet publications in this country. The material distributed includes a weekly newspaper, "Moscow News", two journals of foreign affairs, "New Times" and "International Affairs", a booklet entitled "Current Soviet Documents" which contains the official statements of the Soviet Government and Communist Party, and monthly magazines

such as "Soviet Union" and "Soviet Woman." According to dissemination reports, these publications are made available to bookstores, libraries, private individuals and educational institutions.

The test ban treaty, or the Moscow treaty as it is referred to in Soviet publications, was hailed as demonstrating the possibility of agreement between countries of different social systems and the viability of peaceful coexistence. Official government statements stress that the Treaty, which is described as embodying the Moscow spirit of mutual understanding and cooperation, opens the way for further agreements between East and West and that the Soviet Government is ready to do everything to strengthen peace.

A second major theme of the Soviet propaganda during 1963 concerned the ideological dispute and other differences with China. The "New Times" journal charged that China cannot forgive the Soviet Union for refusing to provide it with samples of the atomic bomb. Soviet policy, it explains, is against the dissemination of nuclear weapons while the Chinese argue that the possibility of nuclear war will be decreased as the number of countries possessing the bomb is increased.

Prior to the signing of the test ban treaty, the Russian publications charged that emphasis by the Western press on the importance of the "hot line" between Washington and Moscow concealed an ulterior motive which is to cover up the failure to reach an agreement in Geneva on disarmament and the discontinuation of nuclear tests.

Other articles expressed the hope for more normal commercial relations with all nations, irrespective of their political and social systems, pointing out that American businessmen in particular had indicated to Russian trade missions that they wanted more trade with Russia. The decision on this matter, the articles state, is left to the United States.

On the economic condition of the Soviet Union, the Russian material emphasized the rapid pace of industrial development and the plans for increasing agricultural production through the use of chemical fertilizers. The gap in industrial production between the U.S.S.R. and the United States is blamed in part on the wars which have been fought on Russian soil.

#### YUGOSLAVIA

The Yugoslav Information Center, the principal source of propaganda from Yugoslavia, distributed a monthly newspaper entitled "Yugoslav Life", a news bulletin containing brief reports of such events as the Skoplje earthquake, and occasional booklets dealing with such subjects as "Higher Education in Yugoslavia" and "The Attitude of the League of Communists of Yugoslavia to Current International Problems." A monthly pictorial magazine, titled "Review", contains articles touching on the cultural aspects of life in Yugoslavia.

On the occasion of President Tito's visit with President Kennedy in Washington, the Yugoslav newspaper explained that past tension with the United States was due to the ideological antagonisms and bloc politics which dominated the policy of the United States especially in the first decade after the war and not to any conflict between the national interests of the two countries. The publication continued saying that the improved international atmosphere following the test ban treaty and the policies of the Kennedy Administration made the conditions for such a meeting favorable.

#### PORTUGAL

Casa de Portugal, a registered agent of the Portuguese Government, disseminated a booklet entitled "Portugal, An Informative Review" and a bulletin of press releases, "Information for the International Press", which were primarily aimed at presenting the Government's views on a number of political subjects. The major topic continued to be Portugal's determination to keep the Provinces of Angola and Mozambique, and the effect of this action on her relations with her allies, and her role within the United Nations.

Selvage and Lee, Inc., a firm registered as an agent of The Overseas Companies of Portugal, a group of commercial enterprises having financial interests.in the Provinces of Angola and Mozambique, is responsible for a wide variety of printed material which is aimed at counteracting anti-Portuguese sentiment in the United States. The basic theme of these publications is that there is no racial discrimination in the provinces as charged by African nationalist groups. Articles also express concern over the lack of firm support given to Portugal by her ally and NATO partner, the United States.

During 1963, Selvage and Lee, Inc., sponsored a tour of newspapermen through the two provinces and distributed the reports which they subsequently wrote. The firm also sponsors the Portuguese-American Committee on Foreign Affairs which distributes material on Angola and Mozambique prepared by Selvage and Lee, Inc. The Chairman of the Committee, Martin T. Comacho, makes frequent use of extemporaneous speeches and letters to the editor to express the Committee's views.

#### REPUBLIC OF CHINA

The increasing weaknesses of the Chinese Mainland in the military, economic, and political spheres was a main theme of the propaganda distributed during 1963 by the Chinese News Service, official information agency of the Republic of China, located in New York City. The "Free China Weekly", a weekly news digest, carried articles about student and peasant revolts, increased defections from the Mainland's army, and economic failures as evidence that morale on the Mainland is shaky. The digest stated that guerilla forces landed on the Mainland were enjoying success and that these raids would be stepped up. One article asserted that Peiping will not be able to explode a nuclear

weapon during the next two to three years as it lacks certain component parts and technological know-how which it is unable to obtain from Russia.

It is also pointed out in "The Free China Weekly" that the rift in Sino-Soviet relations has enhanced opportunities for a successful counteroffensive against the Mainland since the Mao Tse-Tung regime has been weakened by its isolation within the Communist bloc as well as by a general deepening of political and economic crises. The Chinese propaganda cautions the United States and other Western countries from being "taken-in" by the intensified propaganda exchanges between Moscow and Peiping as the current verbal warfare will have no effect on their basic relationship.

Another cautionary note was sounded on the subject of the nuclear test ban treaty. The digest warns that Khrushchev will play the role of peacemaker only so long as it proves advantageous to the U.S.S.R., and that the West should keep past Russian deceits in mind before going too far in its suspension of nuclear offensive and defensive development programs.

Chinese propaganda also expressed opposition

to any "open door" policy toward Mainland China as it smacks of a "Two China" policy and does not take into consideration the deterioration of Communist control on the Mainland.

## SOUTH AFRICA

The official Information Service of South Africa continues to be the major source of propaganda for the Republic of South Africa. Three publications including a monthly news magazine, "South African Scope", a monthly pictorial magazine, "South African Panorama", and a Business Report, carry a wide variety of articles and picture stories on all phases of South African life.

The major topic of a political nature continued to be the policy of apartheid, or separate development, and the resulting progress of the Transkei territory, an area of South Africa set aside for the exclusive use of the Bantu peoples. Much attention was given to the approval of a draft constitution setting up the machinery of self-government for the Transkei, and the first elections for the new Legislature, as well as to other evidence of progress on the social and economic level. The leader of the South African

Delegation to the United Nations was reported as asking the United Nations to examine South Africa's national development policy and to give credit for what had been achieved in the face of misrepresentation and unwarranted condemnation. At the same time, the propaganda carried warnings to nations with an aggressive intent on South Africa that the country's "will and determination to defend and safeguard its heritage by every means at our disposal" should not be lightly discounted.

Registration under the Act does not imply recognition by the United States Government either of the de jure existence or legality of the foreign principal nor does registration indicate approval by the United States Government of the propaganda material disseminated by the registered agent.

The principal purpose of Congress in enacting the Foreign Agents Registration Act was to require public disclosure by persons engaging in propaganda activities and other activities for or on behalf of foreign governments, foreign political parties and other foreign principals, so that the Government and the people of the United States may be informed of the identity of such persons and may appraise their statements and actions in the light of their associations and activities. The emphasis of the Department of Justice in its administration of the statute has been toward the achievement of this purpose. In performing its functions, the Department has continued to rely upon its normal sources of information and upon the investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
