# TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act, which reads:

The Attorney General shall from time to time, make a report to Congress concerning the administration of this Act, including the nature, sources, and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed.

This report is concerned with the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act for the calendar year 1951. It is submitted in supplement to the report of the Attorney General on the administration and enforcement of the Act submitted in June, 1951, covering the calendar year of 1950.

During 1951, forty-eight registration statements were filed by agents of foreign principals as defined in Subsections (1)-( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of

Section 1(c) of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. In addition, seventeen individuals filed registration statements as a result of the agency status created by Section 1(c)(5) of the Act, which is Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950. Twenty-nine registration statements were terminated in the calendar year 1951, leaving a total of two hundred and thirty-seven active registration statements in the Department's files on December 31, 1951, in addition to the seventeen statements filed pursuant to Section 1(c)(5). Exhibits A, or short-form registration statements, were filed by two hundred and sixty-eight individuals as officers, directors, employees or other persons rendering assistance to the registrant in the interest of the foreign principal.

A list of all persons who filed public registration statements under the Act during the year 1951, other than those who filed under the terms of Section 1(c)(5) /Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act7 is contained in Appendix I. The registrants are listed in this Appendix according to registration number; those registrations which have been terminated are indicated therein by an asterisk.

Appendix II consists of an alphabetical list of the same registrants with terminations also denoted by an asterisk. This Appendix also contains the names of the foreign principals as set forth by the registrant, together with a brief description of the nature of the agency.

All registration statements, other than those filed pursuant to Section 1(c)(5) /Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act,

filed with the Department of Justice since June 1942 when the administration of the Act was transferred to this Department, and which were in active status on December 31, 1951, are listed in Appendix III. This list is presented according to geographical areas or nationality field.

Appendix IV contains an alphabetical list of individuals who during 1951 filed an Exhibit A to a registration statement which was submitted in the name of another individual, corporation, partnership or other combination of employees as an officer, director, employee, or other person rendering assistance to the registrant in the interest of the foreign principal.

A functional analysis of statements reported by the registrant is contained in Appendix V. Of the forty-eight registration statements filed in 1951, other than those filed pursuant to Section 1(c)(5), nine were submitted by commercial and financial agents; six are the registration statements of attorneys and five were filed by political organizations with connections in foreign countries.

Appendix VI represents a breakdown of expenditures of foreign government information and tourist offices whose statements were in an active status during 1951. These data are based on the reports filed by these offices. This Appendix also sets forth the number of employees reported by each of these government information and tourist offices. It is noted that the official government information and tourist offices report expenditures of approximately one-half million dollars more in calendar year 1951 than in the previous year, although the total number

of persons employed by these agencies was fewer than in 1950. This increase in reported expenditures does not necessarily reflect a proportionate increase in propaganda activity and is probably to be explained in part by higher operational costs.

Appendix VII contains a table showing the amounts reported as received by certain registrants whose activities as reflected in their registration statements are such as to suggest that their objectives are the influencing of American public opinion and foreign policy. For purposes of comparative study, these amounts are set forth for the three years 1949, 1950, and 1951, and reflect registration statements which were in active status at some time within the three-year period.

Appendix WIII lists the names of registrants who filed statements pursuant to Section 1(c)(5) of the Act. This class of agents was created by Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950 and defines as agent of a foreign principal those persons who have knowledge of or have received instruction or assignment in the espionage, counter-espionage or sabotage service or tactics of a government of a foreign country or of a foreign political party. This Appendix indicates as well the name of the government of the foreign country or of the foreign political party in whose service the registrant acquired the knowledge, instruction or assignment in espionage, counter-espionage or sabotage.

An examination of the political propaganda filed by agents of foreign principals during 1951 indicates that the nature and

content of the political propaganda have not changed materially from that described in previous reports to the Congress. The largest segment of propaganda distributed in this country continues to consist of publications designed to build up good will in the United States toward the country issuing the propaganda, primarily with a view toward attracting tourist traffic and commercial investment.

The files of the Foreign Agents Registration Section reflect the distribution of considerable propaganda material from the Yugoslav Information Center, the Netherlands Information Bureau, and the Government of India Information Offices, as well as a large increase in material disseminated by the Federal Republic of Germany at Bonn and the new State of Israel as distributed by the Israel National Tourist Office, the Israel Office of Information and the Jewish Agency for Palestine. The year 1951 also showed a substantial increase in the amount of propaganda issued by Slovak anti-Communist movements and reflected the increasing tension between the French Government and Morocco and Tunisia. Four Slovak anti-Communist movements filed registration statements during 1951: The National Committee for the Liberation of Slovakia, The Slovak Liberation Committee, The United States Branch of the Slovak National Council Abroad, and Peter P. Pridovak, who also represented the Slovak National Council Abroad. The independence movement of Morocco was represented by the registration of Dr. El Nehdi Ben-Aboud, who registered initially as an individual representing the Istiqlal (Independence) Party of Morocco and who has recently established

the Moroccan Office of Information and Documentation, while the Tunisian independence movement is represented by El Abed Bouhafa as the agent of the Committee for the Freedom of North Africa.

The year 1951 showed a marked increase in the amount of political propaganda disseminated in the United States which emanates from Communist China. This is distributed chiefly by Imported Publications and Products which in its registration statement names among its foreign principals the Hong Kong Distributing Office of People's China and Mezdunarodnaja Kniga, which is the All-Union Soviet book combine with headquarters in Moscow. In the main, however, political propaganda emanating from Soviet-dominated countries continues to be disseminated from the diplomatic missions established by these countries in the United States. The one exception had been the Polish Research and Information Service. This office was ordered closed by the Department of State on August 10, 1951, and thereafter the Polish Government has conducted its informational activities as an embassy function. As has been indicated to the Congress in earlier reports, this Department receives no information through the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act regarding the nature, extent, and amount of funds expended by duly accredited diplomatic or consular officers on this type of activity because of the exemption from registration contained in Section 3(a) of the Act. The Department has been actively considering measures to amend the Foreign Agents Registration Act in order to achieve public disclosure of the nature and sources of political propaganda

emanating from Soviet-dominated countries. Such proposals will be the subject of subsequent communications to the Congress.

The tendency of certain countries to incorporate their informational activities into the functions of their embassies and consulates has been noted in previous reports to the Congress. Upon request of this Department, the Department of State has prepared a list of the foreign countries which confine their informational activity to diplomatic missions. The Department of State advised that the following countries have information officers, including press, publicity and cultural attaches and counselors, in their embassies and do not maintain separate information or tourist offices within this country:

In addition, the diplomatic missions of the Soviet Union and of Hungary issue propaganda publications regularly. The Soviet Embassy in Washington issues the "USSR Information Bulletin" and the Hungarian Embassy issues a publication entitled "New Hungary".

The following countries, while they do have information officers on their diplomatic staffs, operate separate information or tourist offices within the United States, which offices are registered with this Department under the Act:

One criminal prosecution for failure to register under the terms of the Foreign Agents Registration Act was instituted during 1951. The now defunct Peace Information Center, which was responsible for the dissemination in the United States of the so-called Stockholm Peace Appeal, was indicted for failure to register as the agent of the Committee of the World Congress of the Defenders of Peace. This case, which came to trial in the District of Columbia on November 8, 1951, was dismissed by the trial judge on defense motion upon completion of the Government's case. The defense motion upon which the judge ruled was based upon a case decided under the Foreign Agents Registration Act prior to the 1942 amendments, in which the court had held that it was incumbent upon the Government to establish the agency relationship as defined by the Re-Statement of the Law of Agency in order to sustain a conviction for failure to register. It is the

Government's contention that the Foreign Agents Registration Act as amended in 1942 has substituted the statutory definition for the common law definition of the term "agent."

Since the discontinuance at the close of World War II of the unit within the Department engaged in analyzing foreign language materials, reliance has been placed entirely on the Department's normal sources of information and the investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the administration and enforcement of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. The Department has continued, in administering the Act, to emphasize its main and original purpose — the full disclosure of activities within the United States by agents of foreign principals who are engaged in political propaganda activities.
