. The following investigation is producated spon a latter from John C. Keaney, Asting Assistant Astornay Senaral, Criminal Division, United States Department of Justice (USBS) to the Director, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FEI), dated June 13, 1978 which sequented that under the provisions of the Poreign Agents Registration Act (FARA), the FBI should attempt to identify Kelly's source of funds, identify "Marchar" and develope information on one, Humberto Build, whose name Appears as Co-Birector in Kelly's publication "Argentica." (U)

En July 15, 1977, LANARACE W. LEVINE, Attorney, Walab and Levine, 79 Sine Street, New York City (NTC) advised that on day 1, 1978, he had a business lunchoon with Guillerso Patricio Mally at the Hervard Club, 27 West (N) 64th Street, NYC in an effort to have fielly cease and desist from using the same and logos of Argentine Airlines (Aeroliness Argentines) in a newspaper published by Kelly under the same "Argentines) the signified that his firm functioned as legal representatives of this sigline is the United States (US). The sigline the State its public image and business prospects in the US were being injusted by Kelly's underhorized use of its mame and logos in his nowspaper. Levine initiated this luncmeon to detarmine whether or not Kelly would be cooperative and they oliminate the most for formal logal proceedings.

Levine advised that Helly was Encomporative. Levine as impression of their everall conversation was that Kellys warned Levine against persuing this matter in the exerts. Levine noted that Kelly claimed to be an expert marksmans and to always carry a gub with him. He claimed to hold a black belt in karate. He stated that he was propared to die to prevent dryenting from being seizes by the Communists. No stated that under President James Carter, the WS was becoming a Communist mation. He asked if Levine was willing to die to prevent Communists seizing power in the WS. We stated that representatives of Argentine Airlines in the WS had no power over him as his contacts in Argentina ware their superiors. Kelly did not glaborate on this statement.

Levine's talk with Kelly was in the Spanish language since Kelly has only a little knowledge of English words and no shility to speak the English Language. Levine assumes that he will have to take legal action against Kelly to prevent him from using the legas of Argentine Airlines in his paper "Argentina." Levine makes this assumption based upon Kellyks bestile and uncooperative attitude during the course of their conversation. Levine moted that Kelly used composites in both photographs and print to convey false impressions in the paper "Argentina". Levine described felly as short, about 5 feet 54 inches tall, and stocky build.

Levine was advised that if he believed melly represented a threat to Levine's physical safety that he might wish to make this known to the New York City Police Department (NYCPD). I Levine advised that as an atterney he was well aware that this recentse was available to him. He recalls having been advised by Jorge Aja-Espil, an Ambassador of Argentina to the United States (US)\$ that at the funeral of former President Aramburu of Argentina% who was kidnapped and umecuted by guerrillas in Argentina during either late 1960's as early 1970%, that Kelly stated atop his tomb firing a machine fun in protest egainst this man's death at the hands of the guerrillas. Levine stated that he believes Kelly heaf a definite sepacity for violence and wishes no further

perconal contest with him. M(0)

Levine states that high ranking officials of the government of Argentina have advised him that Kelly does not represent the views of that government nor does Kelly have any official connection with that government.

Levine has been advised by people passing thre bis office on business matters that Kelly is receiving financial support from "certain right ming sections of the Argontine Navy" not further identified. (SX -(U)

Levine advised that Mr. Sumpas of the Argentine desk at the United States Department of State (USDS) had told him that Kelly was allowed into the US on a journalist's visa. The Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), by latter dated June 20, 1978, reference number, CO 893-C, advised Levine that on May 19, 1978, Kelly entered the US on a valid-non-immigrant visa, as a visitor for pleasure. This wisa was valid until Argust 18, 1978. Levine stated that Kelly resided at the Hotel Taft, New York City (NEC), while in this area of the United States (DS). (MAC),

Levine advised that Kelly's newspaper was printed by Tallaros Graphicos Pan Americano, 1212-37th Avenue, Long Island City, Gueens, New York (NY). Offset work for this paper was done by an unknown concern at 42nd Street and Park Avenue, Weehavken, New Jersey (NJ). (X/(III)

Levine stated that he had as knowledge of "Marchar" of of anyone named Rumbarto Suldi. He could farmish no data concerning television shows an which Kelly appeared. He know that Kelly seemed to be very well financed but could provide no data concerning any banking connections which Kelly might maintain in the US.

Sulliermo Patricio Relly, aka, William Patrick Kelly, Foreign Agents Registration Act-Argentisa

On August 24, 1978, Arturo Marzio, Regional Manager, Aevolineas Argentinas, 9 Rockefeller Plaza, NYC, advised that be has mover met Guillermo Patricio Kelly and knows of no one who is personally acquainted with him. He stated that he resides in Larchmont, New York (NY) and has almost no contact with the Argentine community in the XEC area. Muzzio is aware of the paper "Argentina" published by Kelly because of its unauthorized use of the legos of this company. He recalled that the matter was referred to a law firm in the NYC area which represented the company's interests here. He added that it was his impression that this paper was no longer being published. The mame Humberto Guidi was unknown to him.

On Argust 24, 1978, Manuel Basaldua, Gameral Manager for Moroliness Argentinas in North America, 9 Rockefeller Plaza, MYC advised that he is not personally acquainted with Guillermo Patricio Kelly and Could suggest no one who might be able to furnish information concerning this Man other than the company's attorney, Lawrence W. Levine, 70 Pine Street, NYC who was handling a legal matter relative to Kelly's unsuthorized use of this sempany's leges in his movapaper. He stated that the mame Sumberto Guidi was unknown to him.

On September 28, 1978, Stefan Giesen, Assistant Manager, Taft Motel, 7th Avenue and 50th Street, NVC advised that he recalled Mr. and Mrs. Guillermo Matriclo Kelly visitinge the Taft Motel, from time to time, during the past two years. He recalls that Mr. Kelly was in the publishing business and sometimes gave out samples of his newspaper. Mr. Geisen was smable to recall either the name of this newspaper of the type of material which it contained. Sometimes Kelly requested that his presence in the hotel be kept confidential so that he would not be troubled by summanted talephone calls. Mr. Giesen was unable to recall Mrs. Kelly's first name. Me recalls that over the past two years Kelly would arrive at the hotel every few menths, remain about a week and thene depart. We never met any of Kelly's associates. The name Mumberto Guidi is unknown to him.

Suillermo Patricio Xelly, aka William Patrick Kelly, Poreign Agente Registration Act-Argentina

On September 20, 1976, John Navaroz, File Clerk, Taft Notel, checked segistration records for some months in 1977 and 1978 but was weable to lessite any information on Kelly.

On September 25, 1978, Anibal Gonzaloz-Gastellu, Posident, New Line Advortising, Suite 108, 200 W. 53th Street, FYC advised that he has had very little contact with Kelly. He stated that he is registered with the USDS as thou representative of TSLAM in the US. He described TSLAM est an Argentine News Agoncy. During 1977 Kelly telephonically contacted him by telephone on several cocasions to arrange for an interview. We tried to avoid any meeting with Kelly: as he was aware of Kelly's political reputation in Argentinal and wanted no association with him. He elaborated by stating that Kelly, in his opinion, tended to hold extreme viewer which were not compatible with the political climate existing in the United States (US). Open first meeting with Kellyn in his office, Kelly suggested that he support Kelly's newspaper "Argentina" and obtain similar support from others Argentines in the US. He explained to Kelly that be has been in the US about 14 years and wasn't interested in the current political situation in Argentine. He is unewaren as to either how or why Relly selected bin in this regard. He is measure as to whether Kelly contacted other Argentines in a similar manner. He had a subsequent luncheon with Relly several months later after which Kelly no longer sought: his support for the newspaper "Argenting." He added that he had received copies of this newspaper thru the mail but had never bothered to read them. He could furnish no information concerning the publication "Marchar" and the name Hymberton Guidi was unknown to bim. XQ (U)

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On September 26, 1978, NYTL, with whom contact has been insufficient to determine the reliability of the information provided but who lived for many years in Argentine

Guillermo Batrick Selly; aka William Patrick Selly, Foreign Agents Registration Act-Argentina

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and who is personally acquainted with Guillerme Patricie Nelly, stated that, about 1936, Selly was convicted of robbery at gun point and jailed. During the 1960's Kelly was the leader of a group called the Alianza Libertadora Macionalista (ALN) which had a bard core membership of about 200 persons. It had a continual campaign against the Jews of Argentina. Upon the overthrow of the Feron government in 1955, the army sent a tank to the ALM headquarters in Buenos Alsesi and blew it up.

NTTI states that Kelly is rumered to have killed one Natalio Selmun Feijco, son of a wealthy merchant in Ruenos Aires, about 1945-1946; because of political disagreements. He is also rumered to have killed a man named Prit in a car during 1954 because of a similar disagreement. Frit was a member of a group called "Radical Fouth" which by WS standards would be very much in the political center. (W)

After the overthrow of President Peron of Argentina in 1955, Relly was imprisoned. He except from jail and fled to Chile where he was equin arrested and imprisonadi but once again sacaped.

NTTI has heard from newsmen in Buence Airesi Argentina and exployees of the government of Argentina that Bolly has been funded by people in the Argentine Navy, in particulari a Captain Perez Froilo. Captain Froilo reportedly accompanied the Foreign Minister of Argentina to the United Nations (FMAUR) during September, 1978. Decomp

NYTI has heard that Nelly's source of sunds has been closed because of complaints arising from his activities in the US. While they were available, Nelly brought his wife to the US for medical treatment and travelled to Paris, France and Wel Aviv, Israel. Selly is said to have asked one newspaperman to write a story on Roslyn Carter's involvement in mental health, for "Argentina", allegedly promising this individual that he would be well paid for his work. Roslyn Carter is the wife of the President of the US.

Guillormo Patricio Kolly, aka William Patrick Kolly, Foreign Agents Registration Act-Argentina

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NTT1 advised that at individual azmed Vistor Fineire, 750 Fark Avenue, NTC, had an article in either the Brd er 4th issue of Kelly's newspaper, "Argentina." Fineiro is reported to have been expelled from the Argentine Havy Sobool about 20 years ago. Now he is reported to have been retained by the Naval Information Service (NIS) of Argentine for the sem of \$6,000 a month. Fineiro is said to function as an unofficial Press Officer over the Argentine Habasey, Washington, District of Columbia (DC) and all Argentine Consulates in the US. Fineiro has no office and operates out of his home. He is said to have sperated a magazine in Buenos Aires, Argentina. (X).(1)

NYT1 states that Kelly has had many asymptoty, all operating in the area described as "yellow press" which indicates lack of respectability and responsible journalism. During the period 1969-1978, Kelly is said to have operated such a newspaper in Buenos Aires with the support of the Minister of the Interior in the Argentine government.

NYT1 could furnish no data concerning anyone named Rumberto Guidi. (U)

On September 26, 1976, A. Edgar Cali, Sales Manager, Pri-Star Offset Corp, 12-12 37th Avenue, Long Island City (LIC), Queens, NY advised that Kelly appeared at their office, between 10 months and 2 years ago; requesting that they print his newspaper "Argentins." He gave no references and paid cash for the work they performed for him. The last issued of the newspaper "Argentina" was printed in May, 1978. There were between 6,000 and 7,000 copies printed at a cost of between 6,000 and 7,000 copies printed at a cost of between 6,000 collars. Kelly seemed a suspicious man and declined any help in preparing these papers for mailing. (W)

Cali described Kelly as about 55 years of age. He is thought to have a son about 22 years of age. On one

occasion Kelly was accompanied by a thin woman about his own age. Cell never heard of anyone named Sumberto Guidi.(U)

On Soptember 25, 1978, MYT2, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that from October 14, 1977 until December 5, 1977, from January 8, 1978 until January 29, 1978 and from February 5, 1978 until Pebruary 8, 1978, Patricic Kelly, Jaramille 2852, Buenos Aires, Argentina, was a resident at the Taft Notel in NYC. (3)

WYT2 stated that during January, 1978, Kelly contacted the following telephone numbers in New Jersey (NJ): $X = \{1, \dots, n\}$

On September 37, 1978, NYT3, with whom contact has been insufficient to determine the reliability of the information provided but who is personally acquainted with Guillermo Patricio Kelly and conversant with political matters in Argentina, advised that Kelly's activities in the United States (US) appeared to have a twofold public relations objective. The first apparent objective was to persuade the US public that "human rights" were not an issue in Argentina. The second apparent objective was to persuade that President Carter's "human rights" was misguided as to Argentina inasmuch as Saws had no problems in that country. [0]

NITS states that one issue of "Argentina" accuses Rabbi Morton Reconthal and Arnold Forster of Enai Brith, 315 Lexington Avenue, NYC of leading a false, libelous compaign against Argentine. NYT3 added that most sopies of "Argentina" could be obtained thru NYT3 if the US government should desire to review them.

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Spillerne Patricic Kelly, aka William Patrick Kelly, Foreign Agents Registration Act-Argentina

WITI advises that Admiral Emilio Massers, who has just Loft the Junta governing Argentina, has strong political ambitions and was secretly funding the activities of Kelly in the US. These funds are so longer available to Kelly insamuch as several months ago Admiral Massera hecama convinced that Kelly was scenter productive to the good image of Argentina which they wished to promote in the US. (M)

MYT3 states that as of several member ego Melly was sick consumers in France. $(X)_{(II)}$

ETTI noted that in one edition of "Argentina" there is an article signed by S. Ross. NYTH suspects that this S. Ross is Stanley Ross, a former editor of "El Bierlo", a Spanish Language newspaper published in the New York (NY) area. Ross is new in Public Relations work and very highly paid. Ross specializes in 4 page advertisements such as that which appeared in the September 25, 1978 issue of the "Well Street Journal", a daily NYC newspaper, on behalf of Argentina. WTH suspects that Kelly might have teamed with Ross in just this type of operation. (MAX)

NYTH states that during late 1977 or possibly early 1978, Kelly appeared on two occasions on Channel 47 television in Nawark, New Jersey (NJ), which is a Spanish Language Television (TV) station. These progress were of a roundtable discussion type, conducted in the Spanish Language, their topics being the threat of Compusion and Ferrorism in Central and South Amorica. NTTH could furnish no data concerning anyone named Humberto Gmidi. MTTH stated that "Marchar" is another of Melly's offerts in the area of "yellow journalism". MYTH made available a copy of its number 7 issue for the year 1975 which lists its directors as Fatricio Melly and Miguel Savec.

Euillerno Petricic Solly, aka William Patrick Kelly, Persign Agents Registration Act-Argentina

On September 28, 1978, NYT4, with show exertast has been insufficient to determine the reliability of the information provided but who is personally sequeinted with Guillermo Patricio Kelly and conversant with political matters in Argentina, advised that Kelly has a reputation for violence in Argentina. At the time, Kelly led a 1000 strong group called the ALN which supported the fermer distator Juan Peron there. Upon Peron's everthrow, Kelly was imprisoned in a remote place in Patagonia, Argentina. He escaped with five other men and went to Chile. The other five were recognized as political exiles in Chile while Kelly was sonsidered a criminal. He was placed in a jail in Santiago, Chile from which he escaped disguised as a women. He was an associate of an American named John William Cooke whom NYT4 has heard subsequently died in Cabe.

NYTA states that Kelly's grandparents emigrated from Ireland to Argentina where the family became confortably middle class. Kelly is considered a senegade son with no family support for his activities. His first marriage ended in a separation. From this marriage, he has a son, about 28 years of age who resides in Buenos Aires, Argentina and a married daughter, about 30 years of age, who resides in Brazil. Helly is currently living with a woman described as about 47 years of age, very thin, with dyed blonde hair. She is thought to be a widow and has been treated in the US within the past few years by medical doctors.

WYT4 expressed the belief that Selly's activities were being funded by a group within the Argentiae Navy. NYT4 stated that about November, 1977 Kelly appeared a few times on Channel 47 in Newark, NJ. NYT4 has beerd that Kelly paid \$5,000 cash for each of these appearances. Se wanted to pay for additional appearances but was discouraged by the station management. NYT4 has heard that the management meat told Kelly that if he wished to make the show a regular one, they would sell him the time but they were unwilling to permit him to buy time for random programs. NYT4 stated

that Carlos Barba la the manager of Channel 47, Nowark, New Forsey (NJ) and sould possibly furnish additional information on Kally's TV appearances there. MYT4 recalled that eas, Diego Sonzalez, an anti-Castro Cuban, apployed as editor of a publication entitled "Impacto" in the NYC areal had appeared as one of Kelly's quests on a Channel 47 TV show. (U)

MTT4 last beard of Kelly a few months ago when it was said he was ill from petitonitis in Paris, France. MTT4 has also heard that Kelly's sources of funds are no longer available to him. As a result, MTT4 expects to see no further issues of "Argentina" published in the US and ho further activities here on the part of Kelly.

NYTA has mover heard of anyone Anned Humberto Guidi. NYTA knew that one, Carlos Pupin, was a close associate of Rolly. NYTA added that Pupin suffers from epilepsy and is thought to be currently residing in Duenos Aires, Argentina.
