





Dear Mr. Meadows:

Per our call today, we request your support in securing needed appropriation to the District's Emergency Planning and Security Fund (EPSF)— the federal funding for the District that is used for special security functions related to our unique role as the Nation's Capital. This fund supports the inauguration, special events, motorcade support for dignitaries and First Amendment demonstrations.

Over the past several weeks, my staff has discussed increased needs for additional funding in the FY 2020 Continuing Resolution (CR) with the staffs of both the Senate and House Appropriations Financial Services Committees, as well as Adam Salazar of the Office of Management and Budget. Our request is based upon recent local and federal law enforcement discussions regarding expected heightened demonstration activity through the election and inauguration.

The District has requested an allotment of \$97.1 million to the EPSF as part of the CR:

- \$35.3 million in extraordinary MPD costs in 2020 through September 30 (EPSF is depleted).
- \$16.9 million for MPD costs anticipated through December 31 for extraordinary First Amendment activity.
- \$44.9 million in costs for Inauguration 2021, including planning, security, construction, supplies, mutual aid, hotels and transportation (Inauguration 2017: \$19.9 appropriated, \$26 million spent, \$7.3 million which was never reimbursed and depleted the EPSF).
