I spent battling the religious discrimination

that had been growing exponentially within the FBI since 2008. There were hundreds of employees who were also alarmed at the hostility emanating from the highest levels of our organization; and as far as I knew, all of our written and verbal complaints were dismissed, often with contempt. Worse than that, for some of us, voicing our concerns resulted in actual harm to us. The FBI's animus against Christian employees was revealed in multiple, initially unexpected incidents; and what began as a discomfort grew to a point where employees were openly mocked, threatened, disciplined, and even constructively dismissed for challenging the political agenda at work in the DOJ and FBI.

There was no method for Christians to associate and share their stories of discrimination at the hands of FBI management. Our every effort to gather together to form a unified defense was prevented; and unsupported "gag-orders" were issued by FBI officials against employees (including me) to prevent the sharing of our testimonies. I have prepared a chronology of the religious harassment about which I was aware; and have, for months, been thoughtfully considering how it might be used. I would like to send it to you for your consideration as part of the Task Force.

Some of the disparate treatment within the FBI was obvious and brazen, other actions were subtle but equally harmful. Without this FBI insider's view of the systemic and widespread manner in which Christians were attacked, it might be difficult to understand the breadth of the religious harassment and the deliberate targeting of those who challenged it. If these avenues are not addressed, the anti-Christian agenda will continue to advance quietly until circumstances allow for its full-blown return.

Although I fought the battle for many years, I am still stunned by the complete disregard for our Constitutional rights inside the very agency tasked with defending them. May it be that your Task Force corrects this travesty. It would be a greater comfort still, if those responsible at the DOJ and FBI were held accountable.

I look forward to hearing from you.





DIRECTIVE (DIR) 2018-03

Directives (DIRs) provide guidance to OFCCP staff or federal contractors on enforcement and compliance policy or procedures. Directives do not change the laws and regulations governing OFCCP's programs and do not establish any legally enforceable rights or obligations.

Effective Date: August 10, 2018

- 1. **SUBJECT:** Executive Order 11246 § 204(c), religious exemption.
- **2. PURPOSE:** To incorporate recent developments in the law regarding religion-exercising organizations and individuals.
- 3. REFERENCES:
 - A. Executive Orders 11246 (Sept. 24, 1965), as amended; 13798 (May 4, 2017); 13831 (May 3, 2018);
 - B. 41 C.F.R. §§ 60-1.5(a)(5), 60-50.1 to 60-50.5; and
 - C. 48 C.F.R. §§ 22.807(b)(7); 52.222-26(b)(2).
- 4. **AFFECTED POLICY:** Described below.
- 5. **BACKGROUND:** The Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP) enforces Executive Order (E.O.) 11246, as amended, Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 503), as amended, and the Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974 (VEVRAA), as amended. Collectively, these laws prohibit federal contractors and subcontractors from discriminating on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, disability, or status as a protected veteran. In addition, contractors and subcontractors are prohibited from discriminating against applicants or employees because they inquire about, discuss, or disclose their compensation or that of others, subject to certain limitations. These laws also require federal contractors and subcontractors to take affirmative steps to ensure equal employment opportunity in their employment processes. In addition, these laws require that federal contracting agencies include in all covered contracts, and that contractors include in their subcontracts, an equal opportunity clause. For definitions of the terms "government contract," "subcontract," "prime contractor," and "subcontractor," see 41 C.F.R. § 60-1.3 (E.O. 11246), 41 C.F.R. § 60-300.2 (VEVRAA), and 41 C.F.R. § 60-741.2 (Section 503). The authority to administer these laws, and to promulgate these regulations, rests solely with the Secretary of Labor.

Section 202 of E.O. 11246 does not apply to "a Government contractor or subcontractor that is a religious corporation, association, educational institution, or society, with respect to the employment of individuals of a particular religion to perform work connected with the carrying on by such corporation, association, educational institution, or society of its activities." E.O. 11246 § 204(c). This exemption is codified in OFCCP's regulations, *see*

41 C.F.R. § 60-1.5(a)(5), and is part of the equal opportunity clause, *see* 48 C.F.R. §§ 22.807(b)(7), 52.222-26(b)(2).

OFCCP's regulations at 41 C.F.R. §§ 60-50.1 to 50.5 "set forth the interpretations and guidelines of [OFCCP] regarding the implementation of Executive Order 11246 . . . for promoting and insuring equal employment opportunities for all persons employed or seeking employment with Government contractors and subcontractors or with contractors and subcontractors performing under federally assisted construction contracts, without regard to religion or national origin." 41 C.F.R. § 60-50.1(a). These regulations also

"clarify the obligations of employers with respect to accommodating to the religious observances and practices of employees and prospective employees." *Id.* § 60-50.1(c).

Recent court decisions have addressed the broad freedoms and anti-discrimination protections that must be afforded religion-exercising organizations and individuals under the United States Constitution and federal law. *See, e.g., Masterpiece Cakeshop, Ltd. v. Colo. Civil Rights Comm'n,* 138 S. Ct. 1719, 1731 (2018) (government violates the Free Exercise clause when its decisions are based on hostility to religion or a religious viewpoint); *Trinity Lutheran Church of Columbia, Inc. v. Comer,* 137 S. Ct. 2012, 2022 (2017) (government violates the Free Exercise clause when it conditions a generally available public benefit on an entity's giving up its religious character, unless that condition withstands the strictest scrutiny); *Burwell v. Hobby Lobby Stores, Inc.*, 134 S. Ct. 2751, 2775 (2014) (the Religious Freedom Restoration Act applies to federal regulation of the activities of for-profit closely held corporations).

Recent Executive Orders have similarly reminded the federal government of its duty to protect religious exercise—and not to impede it. *See* E.O. 13831 § 1 ("The executive branch wants faith-based and community organizations, to the fullest opportunity permitted by law, to compete on a level playing field for grants, contracts, programs, and other Federal funding opportunities."); E.O. 13798 § 1 ("It shall be the policy of the executive branch to vigorously enforce Federal law's robust protections for religious freedom. The Founders envisioned a Nation in which religious voices and views were integral to a vibrant public square, and in which religious people and institutions were free to practice their faith without fear of discrimination or retaliation by the Federal Government. . . . Federal law protects the freedom of Americans and their organizations to exercise religion and participate fully in civic life without undue interference by the Federal Government.").

OFCCP has not yet addressed these legal developments in its regulations or formal guidance.¹

POLICY: In line with the longstanding constitutional requirement that government must permit individuals and organizations, in all but the most narrow circumstances, to participate in a government program "without having to disavow [their] religious character," OFCCP staff are instructed to take these legal developments into account in all their relevant activities, including when providing compliance assistance, processing

complaints, and enforcing the requirements of E.O. 11246. OFCCP staff should bear in mind that:

- They "cannot act in a manner that passes judgment upon or presupposes the illegitimacy of religious beliefs and practices" and must "proceed in a manner neutral toward and tolerant of . . . religious beliefs."³
- They cannot "condition the availability of [opportunities] upon a recipient's willingness to surrender his [or her] religiously impelled status."
- "[A] federal regulation's restriction on the activities of a for-profit closely held corporation must comply with [the Religious Freedom Restoration Act]."5
- They must permit "faith-based and community organizations, to the fullest opportunity permitted by law, to compete on a level playing field for . . . [Federal] contracts."
- They must respect the right of "religious people and institutions . . . to practice their faith without fear of discrimination or retaliation by the Federal Government."⁷

These instructions will remain in force in anticipation of an addition to the Department's regulatory agenda followed by rulemaking informed by public comment.

Religious Liberty Task Force

Freedom of religion has been a core American principle from the very beginning of our country—indeed, it is our "first freedom." President Trump promised that he would make preserving and protecting our religious liberty the first priority of his administration. The Department of Justice is committed to assisting with that effort.

On October 6, 2017, I issued a *Memorandum to All Executive Departments and Agencies on Federal Law Protections for Religious Liberty* (the "Religious Liberty Memorandum"). This Religious Liberty Memorandum, which the President directed me to issue in Executive Order 13798, explained twenty key principles of religious liberty in U.S. law, and provided direction to agencies in four areas: agencies as employers, rulemaking, enforcement actions, and contracting or grant-making.

The same day, I also issued a memorandum within the Department of Justice instructing components on how to implement the Religious Liberty Memorandum (the "implementation memorandum"). This implementation memorandum called on components to incorporate the Religious Liberty Memorandum in all aspects of the Department's litigation, in advice to other agencies, in Department operations, and through its own rulemaking and its interagency rule review. The implementation memorandum required components to notify the Associate Attorney General of all issues that arise which implicate the Religious Liberty Memorandum. It assigned to the Office of Legal Policy the responsibility to review every Department rulemaking or other agency action submitted for Department review by the Office of Management and Budget to ensure its consistency with the Religious Liberty Memorandum, and it designated the Office of Legal Policy as the point of contact for any questions about either document.

Since the issuance of the Religious Liberty Memorandum and the implementation memorandum, the Associate Attorney General's office and the Office of Legal Policy have together coordinated the Department's compliance with both memoranda. The Associate Attorney General's office and the Office of Legal Policy also have worked collaboratively with staff from several other components, drawing on their expertise in this area to ensure compliance with the memoranda and to identify additional opportunities to protect and promote religious liberty.

In order to institutionalize this process, and to leverage the expertise and experience of diverse components within the Department to identify new opportunities for the Department to engage with the issue of religious liberty, today I have established a Religious Liberty Task Force (the Task Force). I will serve as Chair of the Task Force, with the Associate Attorney General serving as Vice Chair for Litigation and the Assistant Attorney General for the Office of Legal Policy serving as Vice Chair for Policy. The Task Force will be further composed of representatives from the Office of the Deputy Attorney General, the Civil Division, the Civil Rights Division, the Environment and Natural Resources Division, the Office of Legal Counsel, the Office of Legal Policy, the Office of Public Affairs, a U.S. Attorney's Office that I will designate, and other components that I may designate from time to time to aid in the Task Force's work.

The Religious Liberty Task Force will continue the Department's ongoing work to implement the Religious Liberty Memorandum and the implementation memorandum. The Task Force will also consider new initiatives that will further the Department's work to protect and promote religious liberty. To that end, the Task Force will: 1) facilitate Department component compliance with the memoranda; 2) address novel, recurring, or cross-cutting issues in the Department's work implicating the memoranda; 3) facilitate interagency coordination regarding the Religious Liberty Memorandum; 4) engage in outreach to the public, religious communities, and religious liberty organizations to obtain feedback on compliance with the Religious Liberty Memorandum; and 5) develop new strategies, involving litigation, policy, and legislation, to protect and promote religious liberty.
