



Jody -

My name is Eugene Kiely. I'm the director of <u>FactCheck.org</u>. If you are not familiar with us, we are a nonpartisan project at the University of Pennsylvania that writes about public policy.

Attorney General Jeff Sessions in <u>his remarks on the new travel ban</u> yesterday said, "today more than 300 people who came here as refugees are under FBI investigation for potential terrorism-related activities."

What does he mean by "under FBI investigation"? Are the "more than 300 people" under full investigation, preliminary investigation, or are they at the assessment level?

I ask, because as the Congressional Research Service explained in an April 2013 report:

Agents and analysts may now use assessments outside of the more traditional preliminary and full investigations, which require some level of factual predication.78 Preliminary investigations can be opened with "any 'allegation or information' indicative of possible criminal activity or threats to the national security." Opening a full investigation requires an "'articulable factual basis' of possible criminal or national threat activity."80 On the other hand, opening an assessment does not require particular factual predication.

I'm trying to put the 300 figure in some context, but I need to know how the Attorney General defines the term "under FBI investigation."
