





This past August:

- -On August 22, the Secretary of State, Mike Pompeo, traveled to the White House for a meeting about the annual refugee cap.
- -That afternoon, he was planning to join the other "Principals," including Kirstjen Nielsen and John Bolton.
- -Even though it was fairly late in the process, there was still uncertainty about the final figure.
- -Secretary Pompeo wanted the number to be consistent with where it was this past year, at forty-five thousand. Others, including Stephen Miller, at the White House wanted it to be lower.
- -Miller scheduled a meeting a few hours before the Principals Committee meeting that afternoon.
- -After the first meeting, Miller canceled the Principals Committee meeting, scheduled for later that afternoon.
- -The Principals Committee Meeting was finally held last Friday (9/14).

Earlier in August:

- -After a meeting among officials from the State Department, DHS, and DoD, a so-called "summary of conclusions" mischaracterized the positions of the Department of Defense and the State Department.
- -Their explicit support for forty-five thousand was cast in deliberately vague terms without reference to a specific figure.

General Commentary:

-I don't go into deep speculation about Secretary Pompeo's change in position, but I do note that the Secretary's position seemed to change between August 22 and this past Monday, when he made the announcement about the new refugee cap.
