TIMETABLE:	As soon as possible.
SUMMARY:	The Special Counsel requests confirmation of his authority to investigate the matters identified below. The requested confirmation facilitates an efficient, full, and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election. As noted below, it may be appropriate to reassign certain matters identified below to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component at some point in the future. I recommend that you confirm the authority of the Special Counsel

# DISCUSSION:

On May 17, 2017, you appointed Robert S. Mueller III as Special Counsel "to ensure a full and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election," and specified his investigative and prosecutorial authority. Order No. 3915-2017. Thereafter, on August 2, 2017, you executed a classified memorandum that further identified specific matters included within the Special Counsel's investigative authority. During the course of his investigation of the authorized matters, the Special Counsel has identified additional individuals whose conduct he should investigate in order to fulfill his responsibilities as set forth in the appointment order. Those individuals and the basis for their inclusion within the Special Counsel's investigative purview are more fully described below.

# I. Individuals whose conduct is directly within the scope of the investigation.

The Special Counsel's Office (SCO) has been meeting with the Office of the Deputy Attorney General every other week to provide a briefing on the progress of the investigation. During those briefings, the SCO has provided sufficient information to establish that the conduct

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of additional individuals other than those named in the classified memorandum should be investigated as part of a full and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election, including any links and/or coordination between the Russian government and individuals associated with the campaign of President Donald Trump. Confirmation of the authorization to investigate such individuals does not suggest that the Special Counsel has made a determination that any of them has committed a crime. Rather, the Special Counsel has learned information such that further investigation of the pertinent activities of Michael Cohen, Richard Gates, the Roger Stone, and

is necessary for the Special Counsel to fulfill his responsibilities under the appointment order. I recommend that you confirm the authority of the Special Counsel to conduct that investigation.

# II. Individuals who are possibly engaged in jointly undertaken activity pertaining to authorized matters.

The Special Counsel has also identified persons or entities who may have been engaged in jointly undertaken activity with individuals the investigation of whom you previously determined to be within the scope of your appointment order. Investigation by the Special Counsel of these additional persons or entities would be consistent with the ordinary course for a United States Attorney's Office or a Department component. In other words, any such office investigating potential criminal activity by one person would include within the same investigation individuals or entities who may have been jointly involved to determine whether they are targets, subjects, or witnesses, or are wholly uninvolved. This practice increases efficiency by avoiding multiple investigations of the same conduct. It also enables the prosecuting office to be aware of the full scope of the conduct to accurately assess the relative culpability of all involved and to identify and obtain the cooperation of co-defendants and witnesses. Assignment at this time of the investigation of persons or entities who may have engaged in jointly undertaken activity to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component would create the possibility that an individual with relevant information about the Special Counsel's investigation might come forward with that information after the Special Counsel concludes his investigation. This occurrence would raise questions about the completeness of the Special Counsel's investigation and the accuracy of his conclusions. Confirmation of the Special Counsel's authority to investigate these matters would not preclude reassignment of such matters to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component at a later time.

You previously confirmed the Special Counsel's authority to investigate allegations that Paul Manafort committed a crime or crimes arising out of payments he received from or on behalf of the Ukrainian government before and during the tenure of President Viktor Yanukovych. The Special Counsel has determined that the following individuals or entities may have been jointly involved in that conduct: Richard Gates:

I recommend that you confirm

the Special Counsel's authority to investigate those individuals and entities in connection with their possible participation in that conduct.

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You also previously confirmed the Special Counsel's authority to investigate allegations that Michael Flynn committed a crime or crimes by acting as an unregistered agent of Turkey. The Special Counsel has determined that Bijan Rafikian and Ekim Alptekin may have been jointly involved in that conduct. I recommend that you confirm the Special Counsel's authority to investigate those individuals and entities in connection with their possible participation in that conduct.

## III. Michael Cohen

In the course of the investigation, with respect to Michael Cohen, the Special Counsel has discovered investigative leads the pursuit of which may result in the discovery of criminal conduct not directly related to the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election. Those leads relate to Cohen's establishment and use of Essential Consultants LLC in order to, *inter alia*, receive funds from Russian-backed entities. Because the investigation has also revealed links between Cohen and Russian government officials, the Special Counsel would like to pursue those leads for at least two reasons: (1) there is some evidence that certain of Cohen's actions may relate to the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election; and (2) Cohen may have information relevant to the Special Counsel's investigation, and pursuit of the leads may help to secure Cohen's cooperation, thus furthering the Special Counsel's full and thorough investigation of the Russian government's efforts to interfere in the 2016 presidential election. I recommend you confirm the authority of the Special Counsel to pursue the referenced leads.

Summary recommendation

Based on the briefings the Special Counsel's Office has provided, I believe that the matters over which the Special Counsel seeks to confirm investigative authority are sufficiently predicated and appropriately within the scope of your appointment order. Further, centralizing the investigation of the identified matters with the Special Counsel for the time being will lead to a more timely and credible resolution of the investigation, which is squarely in the Department's and the nation's interests. For these reasons, I recommend you confirm the Special Counsel's authority to investigate the named individuals and matters in addition to those individuals and matters identified in the previously referenced classified memorandum.

With respect to any of the matters within the investigative authority of the Special Counsel, should the Special Counsel determine that: (1) the criminal conduct is unrelated to the

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purpose of his appointment (and unrelated to matters addressed by 28 C.F.R. § 600.4(a)); and (2) charging the conduct is not likely to lead to discovery of relevant information, then that matter should be considered for reassignment to a United States Attorney's Office or Department component for prosecution.

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

OHR met STEELE in 2007, sometime before a January 2008 conference they both attended. OHR remembers he was at a conference when Simeon Mogilevich was arrested in Russia in January 2008 and their first interaction took place prior to that event. As the Chief of DOJ's Organized Crime and Racketeering Section at the time, OHR met STEELE in London at . STEELE was an expert on Russia, specifically Russian organized crime, and was concerned the west was not taking the Russian threat seriously. Russian oligarchs are brilliant yet cold-blooded and do not act like adults as they kill people for nothing. Over the years OHR and STEELE had a few more meetings before OHR left and joined or founded Orbis. OHR and STEELE would see each other once a year in London or the U.S. STEELE had paid clients, yet provided OHR with the same short intel reports from a variety of subsources that were well placed. OHR introduced STELE to his eventual handler, SA statements from the FBI's New York Field office.

OHR believes that **STEELE** kept his sources upon leaving . OHR does not know if **STEELE** kept the sources but there was a strong context that **STEELE** did keep the sources and that is what OHR drew from it.

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OHR believes Russian oligarchs will provide information to the FBI because in Russia everyone talks to the police. Following the 2014 Ukrainian invasion OHR met with and STEELE in OHR recalled the three talked about engaging with prospective oligarchs, and that meeting led to a meeting between the FBI,

In the 2011 timeframe, **STEELE** introduced the FBI to the source that predicated the FIFA case. The source may not have been the source who initiated the case, but contributed to the start of the case.

In late July 2016, possibly Saturday, July 30, 2016, STEELE called OHR and asked to meet for breakfast as STEELE was in Washington, D.C. and had some serious stuff to talk about. STEELE planned to also tell SA about the information STEELE had collected. OHR met STEELE for breakfast where OHR was told that Carter Page had met with high level officials in Russia. Page met with Sechin and one other person. The media had already documented Page's trip to Moscow at that time. The FSB had Trump over a barrel according to a high level Russian official who advised former who reported to STEELE . In addition, was furious at Paul Manifort and was making a case against him. \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_ were almost ready to talk to the U.S. about the money Paul Manifort stole. STEELE claimed he had already given some of this reporting to SA and planned to give the rest to him. At that time, STEELE had provided with two reports regarding these topics while Glen Simpson had four. OHR provided copies of notes he took during and after the meeting with STEELE, which are enclosed as attachments.

OHR knew Glen Simpson hired STEELE to dig up Trump's connections to Russia. OHR's wife is a Russian translator and was hired to conduct open source research. Even though she did not know the goal of the project, she was able to surmise the purpose as the individuals she was researching were close to Trump. OHR knew that Glen Simpson was hired by a lawyer who does opposition research. OHR knew STEELE services reporting on Trump's ties to Russia were going to the Clinton Campaign, Jon Winer at the U.S. State Department and the FBI. OHR was aware that Simpson was passing STEELE 's information to many individuals or entities and at times STEELE would attend meetings with Simpson.

OHR met STEELE in Washington, D.C. in late September, possibly close to the time when the Yahoo news article was published on September 23, 2016. During that meeting, STEELE advised the Alfa server in the US is a link to the Trump campaign and Sergei Millian's Russian/American organization in the U.S. used the Alfa server two weeks

OHR has never met the business partner of STEELE . On one occasion, OHR met with STEELE and STEELE brought a tall, young, male associate, but it was not STEELE' business partner.





OHR has never been present during meetings between STEELE and Jon Winer. OHR is only aware that STEELE and Winer have met as STEELE advises OHR that the meetings occur.

Glen Simpson directed STEELE to speak to the press as that was what Simpson was paying STEELE to do. OHR does not know if STEELE going to Mother Jones was Simpson's idea or not.

Glen Simpson hired OHR's wife to conduct research for his firm. OHR will voluntarily provide his wife's research to the FBI. OHR provided the interviewing Agent with a report on Paul Manafort. The report titled, "Manafort Chronology", was scanned and is a digital attachment to this document.

Bruce OHR, **Construction Construction Construction** currently the Associate Deputy Attorney General and Director of the Department of Justice's Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) was interviewed at FBI Headquarters. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

OHR had breakfast at Peet's Coffee, 11th and E St. NW, Washington, D.C. with Glenn Simpson at 10:00 A.M. on December 10, 2016. During breakfast Simpson provided OHR with an 8GB Verbatim USB micro digital media drive (thumb drive). OHR does not know what is on the thumb drive but believes it is in regards to the work **STEELE** was hired to do for Simpson. The thumb drive was entered into evidence at WFO as original evidence and a working copy CD-ROM was produced for investigative use. An evidence FD-302 was generated and serialized to this file.

OHR took notes after the meeting with Simpson to preserve his memory and referred to them during the interview. OHR's notes are an attachment to this document.

Simpson identified Michael Cohen, a lawyer in Brooklyn, NY as having many Russian clients in the Brighton Beach, NY area. Cohen is the go-between Russia and the Trump Campaign and replaced Paul Manafort and Carter Page. Cohen's wife's last name is Shusterman and her father is a major real-estate developer in Moscow with ties to the Kremlin. Cohen may have attended a meeting in Prague, possibly in September, regarding the Trump Campaign and the Russians.

According to Simpson, much of his collection about the Trump campaign ties to Russia comes from a Simpson does not know his name.

A former Trump campaign official, possibly Rick Wilson, was talking about some of the Trump ties to Russia and the Trump Campaign tried to sue him for violating his non-disclosure agreement.

A Russian senator and mobster named Torshin may be involved in running the Central Bank of Russia. Torshin's name comes up in in Law Enforcement Organized Crime circles as he is well known in a famous Spanish case that shows direct linkages between Russian Organized Crime, Torshin and the Russian Government. Torshin may have funneled Russian money to the National Rifle Association (NRA) to use in support of Trump. An NRA lawyer, found out about the money pipeline and was very upset, but the election was over by the time for learned of it. Simpson stated there are pictures or Torshin with Trump. Simpson provided OHR with an article on the NRA and Torsion. The article is an attachment to this document.

Some of Simpson's staff believe the NRA spent an abnormally large amount of money during the election, possibly indicating Russian involvement, but others in his company disagree.

The New York Times story from October 3, 2016, that downplayed the connection between Alfa Bank servers and the Trump campaign was incorrect. There was communication and it wasn't spam. Mikhail Fridman lied in the written statement that he gave to the New York Times and Washington Post. Fridman claimed he never met Trump, however there are pictures to the contrary.

Simpson received a bizarre tip on December 9

Simpson is not sure whether to believe this.

Simpson still thinks Sergei Millian is a key figure connecting Trump to Russia. Looking at Millian led Simpson's company to Cohen. Simpson would be surprised if Millian was still in the U.S. Simpson believes Millian is an SVR officer, however he is deducing this from Millian's alias, not because he was told Millian was SVR. Millian may have overseen many financial transfers from Russia to assist the Trump campaign.

OHR asked Simpson if he was concerned about his personal safety. Simpson responded that he learned from his Russian investigative reporting what they were capable of but there was no way for him to know if they were coming after him. Simpson mentioned that someone called and asked him to find out where all of the Alfa Bank stories were coming from. Simpson did not state this was a threat from the Russians, but that was the impression made upon OHR based upon the timing of the comment and using that story as a response to OHR's guestion.

Bruce CHR, Bruce CHR, Currently the Associate Deputy Attorney General and Director of the Department of Justice's Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) was interviewed at FBI Headquarters, 935 Pennsylvania Ave., Washington, DC. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Special Agent and Intelligence Analyst and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

On January 20, 2017, OHR received an e-mail from Glen Simpson asking OHR to contact Simpson. OHR subsequently contacted Simpson telephonically. During the telephonic conversation, Simpson told OHR that one of Christopher Steele's employees has been identified and will likely be publicly named by the media within the next couple of days. Simpson did not know the identity or contact information of the employee, only that the employee was intimately involved in compiling the information contained within the dossier on Donald J. Trump and the Trump campaign. Due to the sensitive nature of the employee's work and contacts, revealing the identity of the employee could place the employee in danger. Simpson was considering putting the employee in contact with an attorney to advise the employee. When OHR asked for more information regarding the employee and the nature of the threat, Simpson replied he would contact Steele for more information and then re-contact OHR.

In the early hours of January 21, 2017, OHR received a text message from Steele which OHR did not notice until later in the morning. Around 8:00 am on the same day, OHR received call from Steele. During this conversation Steele relayed his concerns regarding the safety of his

Continuation of FD.302 of January 2017 employee if the employee's name was released in the media. Steele stated if the employee's name was released, the employee "may need help quickly." Steele has been unable to directly contact the employee indicating the employee was alright. When asked for the employee's identity, Steele replied that he did not have the employee's permission to share the information, but if contact was needed, . whom Steele identified as and was known to both Steel and OHR could arrange contact. Steele believed the employee, , would be scared if the JS Government contacted the employee; the employee's natural inclination would be to 'lay low.' In addition to the publication of the employee's name, an individual Steele identified as was about to be exposed (NFI) in the public which would also lead to the employee being identified.

Steele also told OHR that he spoke with a staff member of Senator John McCain's office sometime prior to October 2016. Steele had this conversation at the request of **Steele**. Since October 2016, Steele had not spoken to anyone regarding the Trump dossier.

OHR took notes during the contact with Simpson and Steele to preserve his memory and referred to them during the interview. OHR's notes are an attachment to this document.

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Special Agents and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information: On January 24, 2017, OHR received a WhatsApp notification from Christopher Steele. On January 25, 2017, Steele contacted and spoke with OHR via WhatsApp. During this conversation, Steele again relayed his concerns regarding the safety of his employee. Due to the possibility of the employee's identity being exposed by the media, the employee had 'went to ground' but recently 'semi-emerged' (NFI) indicating Steele could establish contact. Steele's concern was exacerbated by additional media reporting on Steele re-iterated to OHR the employee was an "absolute gem." Steele would attempt contact with the employee on January 2017 to "see where he is." After Steele spoke with the employee, Steele would re-contact OHR.

OHR took notes during the contact with Steele to preserve his memory and referred to them during the interview. OHR's notes are an attachment to this document.

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Special Agents and the nature of the interview, OHR provided the following information:

OHR stated he had been contacted by Christopher Steele, via WhatsApp, on January 31, 2017. On January 30, 2017, the Trump Administration fired Acting Attorney General Sally Q. Yates and Steele had contacted OHR to determine if OHR anticipated being fired as well and, if so, who in the Department of Justice could he continue to reach out to. OHR added that he had previously explained to Steele at some point, his contact with the U.S. Government would have to involve the FBI. Interviewing agents asked OHR to ask Steele if he would be comfortable getting the name of an FBI agent.

OHR advised Kathleen Kavalec, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Bureau of European and Eurasian Affairs, U.S. Department of State would be meeting representatives in order to discuss potential Russian influence in their upcoming Presidential elections. OHR reminded the interviewing agents Kavalec did speak with Steele several times prior to the 2016 US Presidential election and believed Steele's reporting to have generated from mainly one source.

OHR stated he had recently been contacted by Christopher Steele on three separate occasions via WhatsApp or FaceTime. On 12 March 2017, Steele told OHR he was concerned about receiving a letter from Senator Grassley asking Steele to disclose additional details regarding the dossier Steele compiled on Donald J. Trump. Steele also expressed concern about the well-being of one of his previous employees who was instrumental in obtaining the information published in the dossier.

On 15 March 2017, Steele told OHR if asked, Steele would tell the investigating congressional committees what he could about the dossier, but Steele must protect the sources and methods used to collect the information.

STEELE was specifically concerned about anything Director Comey would say that might expose a sensitive source. STEELE was happy with Director Comey's response.

In a previous conversation, STEELE had expressed concern for the well-being of a source. STEELE described the current disposition of this source as "stable".

STEELE informed OHR that the disclosure laws in the UK were more narrow than in the United States and therefore limited his ability to testify before Congress. STEELE cited specifically that he was restricted from
