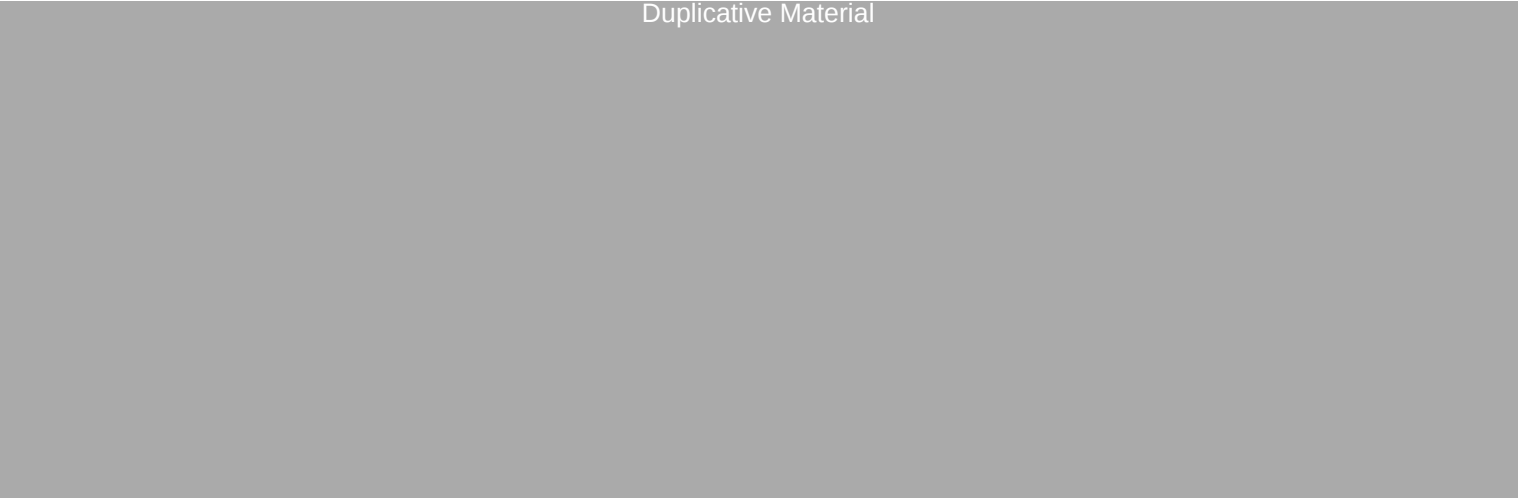

Hi, Neil – Here are some additional thoughts on possible Watergate pardons:

- Attached is a set of some two dozen documents I've uncovered that detail the massive due process violations committed by Watergate judges and prosecutors. The first six deal with President Nixon; the remainder concern the Cover-up Trial.
- Both involve a specially-recruited, Ivy League dominated, set of prosecutors, whose leader was never confirmed by the Senate, undertaking dozens of politically-motivated prosecutions. Jaworski even lamented in writing to his deputy the overwhelming goal to get Nixon "at all cost."
- There are then two separate possible actions to pursue:
 - Watergate Pardons. There are dozens of defendants convicted in actions brought by the five WSPF Task Forces (Watergate, Plumbers, Campaign Finance, Dirty Tricks and ITT), some far more prominent than others. The judicial and prosecutorial wrongdoing is vividly detailed in the internal prosecutorial documents I've uncovered.

Gordon Liddy, James McCord and Jeb Magruder, although I admit each could be justified on humanitarian grounds. "Everyone but Dean" certainly does have appeal!

A Report detailing all the wrongdoing could accompany your pardon recommendation, which could be accomplished in one comprehensive Executive Order.

- President Nixon. Nixon was neither convicted nor impeached, although he was named an unindicted Cover-up co-conspirator by the grand jury. He also has already been pardoned (by President Gerald Ford (on September 8, 1974). Still, the falsehoods and misrepresentations contained in both prosecutors' "Road Map" and the Nixon Prosecutive Memo of June 28, 1974, both shared in secret with the House Judiciary Committee, show that he was the object of substantial prosecutive abuse.

This falls under Ed Martin's responsibilities for investigating DOJ weaponization. What might be appropriate is a full Report to President Trump detailing all the wrongdoing, which could be released in conjunction with some posthumous award, such as the Medal of Honor, that also praised Nixon's many accomplishments.

These two actions might better be done in separate events.

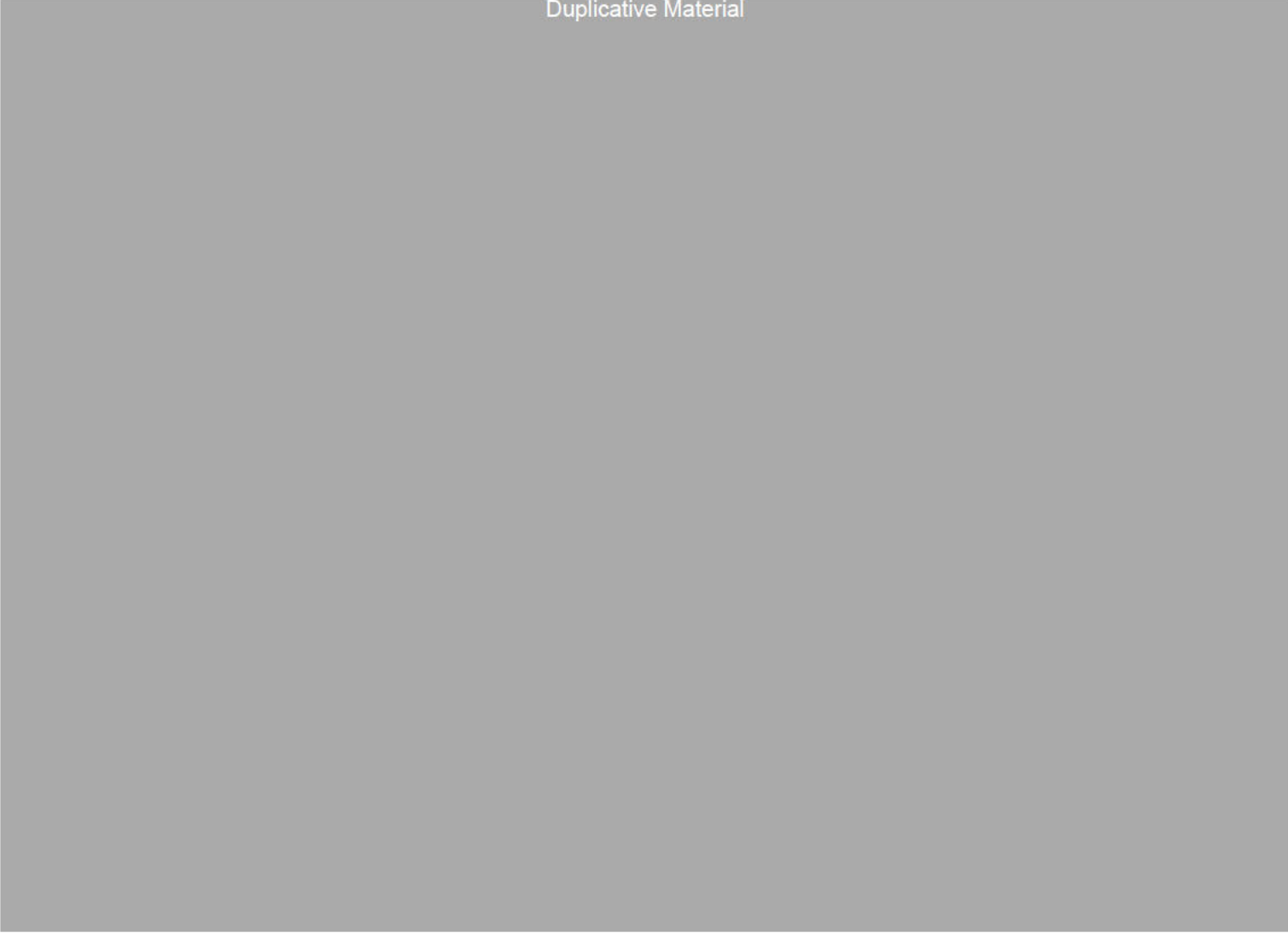

Good evening gentlemen,

Thank you for meeting with us today regarding clemency options for certain U.S. Army Soldiers charged with crimes.

Attached is an article which analyzes the unique powers of clemency of the President, specifically in regards to his role as Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the United States, and thus, the senior-most military commander within the military command structure.

The Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) gives the President the authority to convene a court martial under the General Court Martial Convening Authority (GCMCA). As a GCMCA, the President may also issue an order "Disapproving the Findings and Sentence" of any court martial, under Article 860(a) of the UCMJ.

The form of this action would likely be a Presidential Memorandum directed to the Secretary of the Army, citing the relevant statutes (see, e.g., Art. 75 UCMJ), naming the specific Soldier to be affected, and directing the Army how to dispose of his case (e.g., send him back to active duty, grant him an honorable discharge, give him back-pay, don't give him back-pay, etc).

Thank you again for taking interest in the military's politically-motivated system of justice, which has ruined so many Servicemembers' lives under previous administrations' penchant for using the military courts as a forcing function of various liberal social experiments.

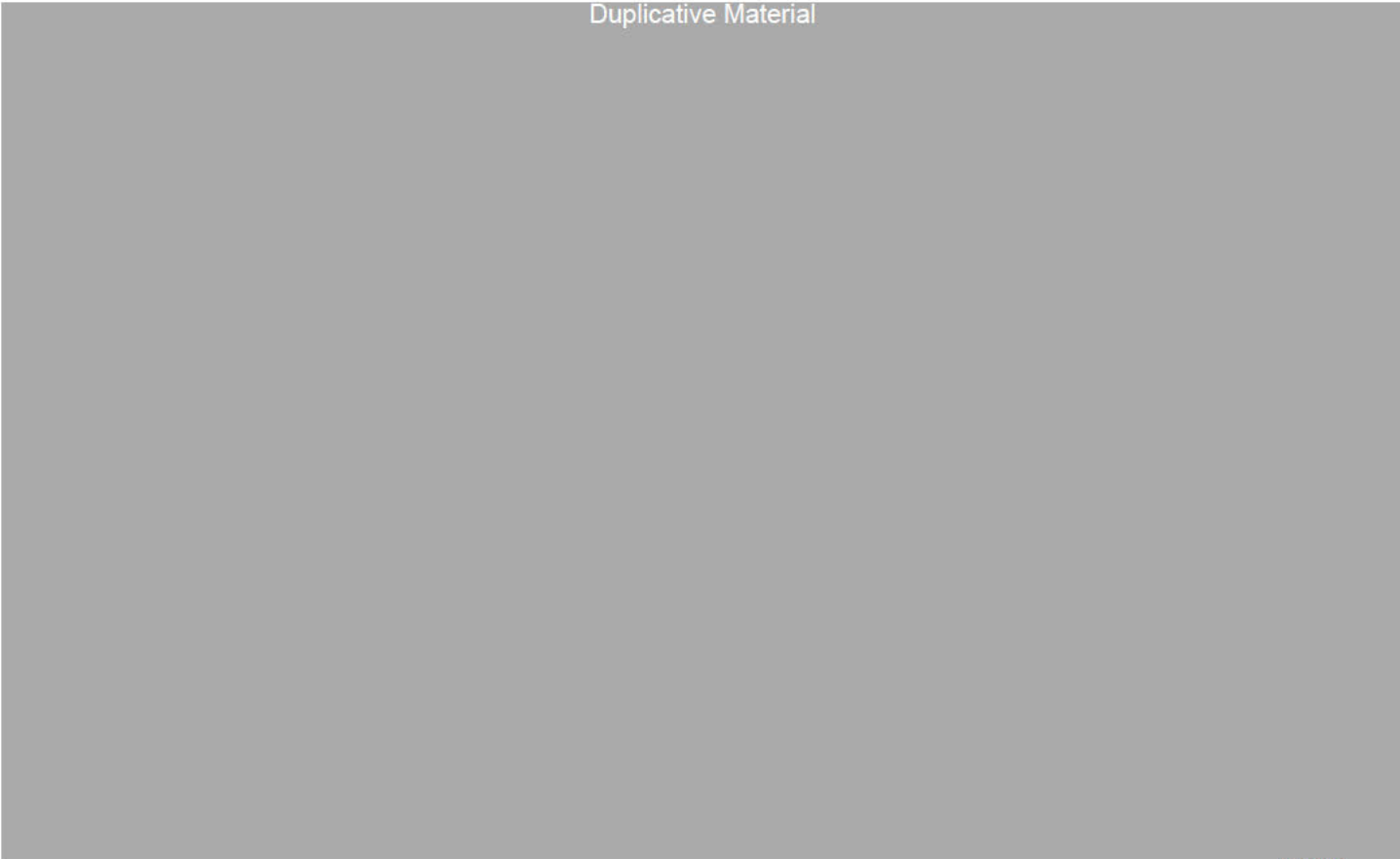

Thank you for sharing your email address and for taking the time to look at my case involving the illegitimate use of the autopen. The autopen is the tip of the iceberg in my case.

Attached you will find the confirmed autopen document that President Biden's staff used to remove me from 2-star promotion list on 28 March, 2024. There is no evidence that POTUS was aware of this action, as required by the governing statute. We have confirmed the use of Autopen #2 (per Sen Cruz's chart during the Theo Wold hearing) - used from Feb 1, 2024 to Jan 19, 2025. This is the first potential violation of the law.

The second set of violations is captured in the attached appeal, under the authority of Executive Order 14147, *Ending the Weaponization of the Federal Government*, which tasks the Justice Department to take action against government agencies that targeted individuals. While the EO mentions law enforcement and the intelligence communities, Section 3 ultimately leaves the door open for individuals from all departments and agencies to seek relief. I would like to submit this appeal (attached) to President Trump via your office, which should have jurisdiction.

I would humbly request that you read the short intro and the 1-page exec summary of my appeal, plus the short conclusion on page 9. I would highlight the statutory violations regarding the exclusion of exculpatory evidence, the exclusion of pertinent witnesses, failure to conduct witness credibility, overly broad interpretations of the law (in violation of the recent *Loper Bright Enterprises v. Raimondo* SCOTUS case), illegal promotion delays, serious conflicts of interest, and failure to follow numerous regulations and procedures.

After fighting this Marxist attack for the last 3.5 years, for just doing my job and standing against DEI, I am happy to go public and allow this case to be used as you and your team desire to bring light to these abuses.

I write today because we are participants in a great effort of Presidential power. I want the world to know what we do and how we do it. For this reason, please feel free to share this email about our work and mission widely.

First, thank you for being interested in clemency. We honor your effort. Please [visit the Pardon Office website](#) to find out more about what a pardon is and how we operate.

Second, if you think that you or a loved one is eligible for some form of clemency, please fill out an application. This is an important step because it gets you into our system so that we can track things as they move forward, especially when documents or reports are sent in.

Third, feel free to reach out to elected officials in your home community—also, feel free to reach out to either Alice or me or both. We honor your efforts.

Fourth, beware of the "too good to be true" offers. Please show caution when someone tells you that they have a magic plan or method to get a pardon or commutation. Some of these people may have real success in this process, but too often they promise something they can't deliver, and they may be taking advantage of you or your loved one.

After a clemency request is uploaded, please [use this Pardon Office status portal](#) to check on status and ascertain the reference number, P##### for pardons or C##### for commutations. This number is critical for staff as well as for the applicant. Don't wait and don't let the perfect be the enemy of the good – fill out the app! Trust me, you want an application in our system as soon as possible – a lot becomes possible because of this.

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In all of this, please make your case as best you can. After this, we ask you to trust the process and of course hope and pray for the best. Which brings me back to Donald J. Trump. From the very start of his presidency, he embraced the pardon power as a way to give relief to those in need. His compassion is second to none in American history – from the First Step Act to his record of pardons/commutations, he is focused on helping ‘we the people.’

Over and over his desire to serve the “forgotten man and woman” comes through. He – and we - see you and your efforts. And we view our work as getting your stories to the President so he can make his decisions. We take the process seriously and with deep respect for you and your position. This is how the President directs us. Good luck and God bless you.

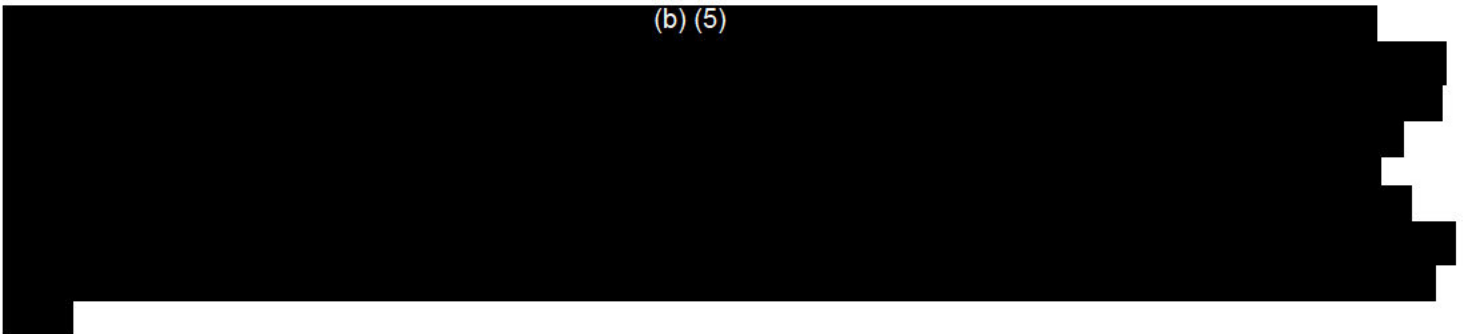

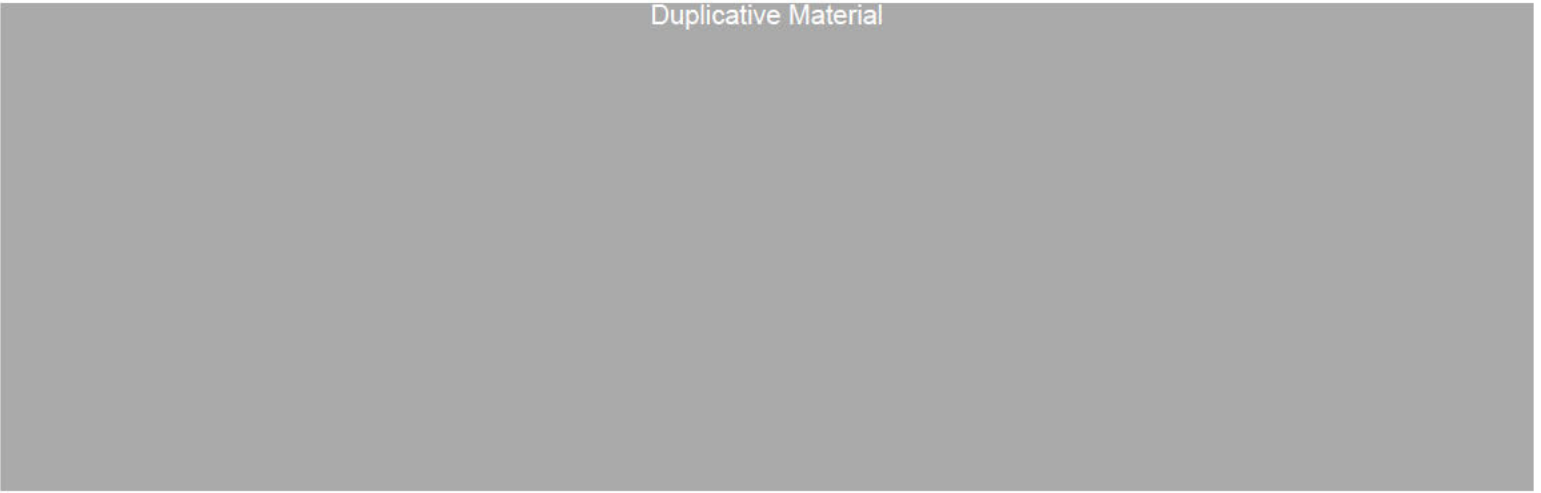

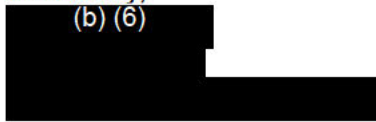
I am a New York State resident. I have been sued multiple times within Westchester, Albany and now Dutchess' counties circuit courts. The initial complaint was dismissed with prejudice due to improper service. She had a process server come to my home at 11:30 in the evening. I live in a very rural community. It was completely unprofessional. In 2016 I transferred to [REDACTED] (b) (6) as a junior full time student. After securing work that coincided with my degree program, I was unable to fulfill my full time schedule in my second semester. I asked [REDACTED] (b) (6) how to resolve this, and was advised to withdraw myself as a full time student and move to part time status. I followed the recommendation from the school's advisors, not realizing it was also tied to the amount of financial aid I would receive. This left me with a bill at the end of the semester, which I also was advised to write to the registrar and ask that they review what had transpired. They refused my request to adjust the bill. They initially were charging me over \$6,000. That is representative of about half of my annual income. Anyway, I refused to pay, asking for further review, which was denied.

That's when I started getting sued by NY State. This wasn't me signing up for classes and not showing up. This was a traceable paperwork change. I have the documentation. I presented these to the courts. Finally I was threatened with a criminal complaint in Dutchess County's Supreme Court. I cracked and have been making payments on a reduced amount of approximately \$2500. Why they dropped the amount down, I don't know. The AG's office also refuses to apply my payments properly, the last payment I sent in, I received notice that my "payment of \$0.00 was applied to \$0.00 balance". I have no idea what that even means. Apparently the "payment specialist II" with NY state can't figure out how to apply my payment that I'm being forced to pay.

Mr Martin, all of this continues while NY State hands out free tuition to ILLEGAL ALIENS. Please see provided link :<https://www.hesc.ny.gov/applying-aid/nys-dream-act>
I would appreciate any suggestion(s) on how to handle any of this. I have all correspondence with SUNY Purchase and NYS AG's office.

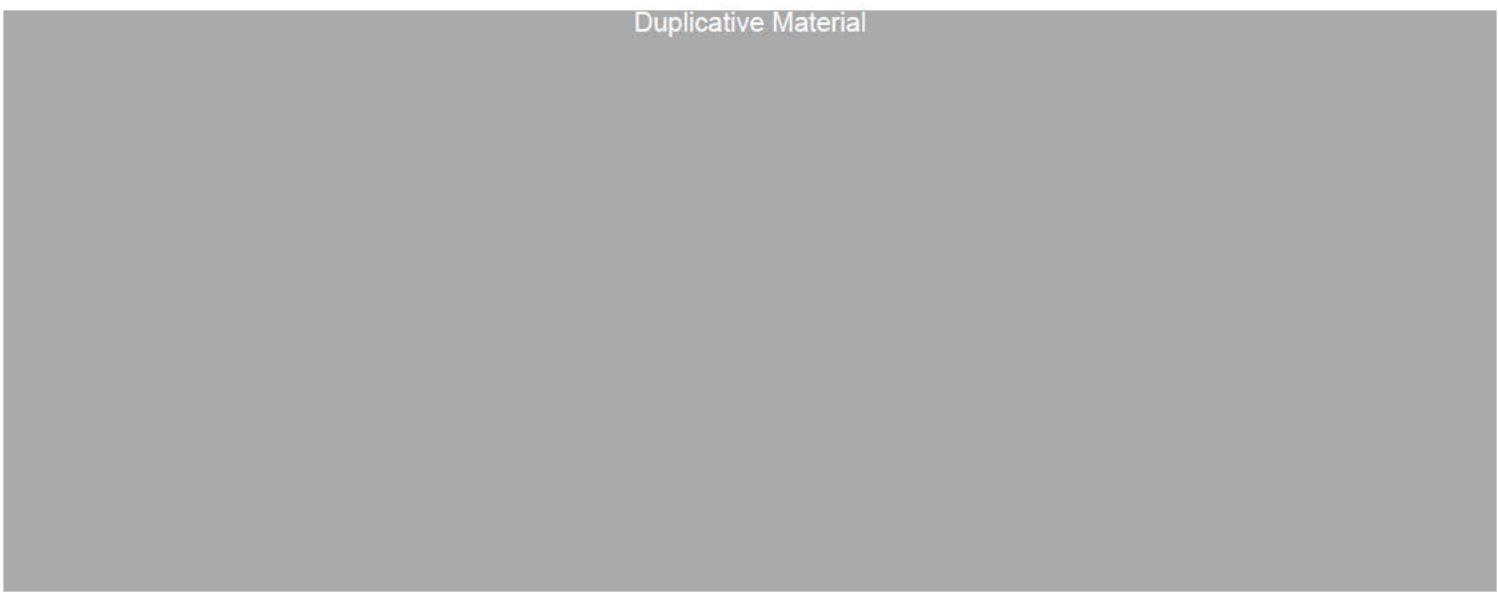

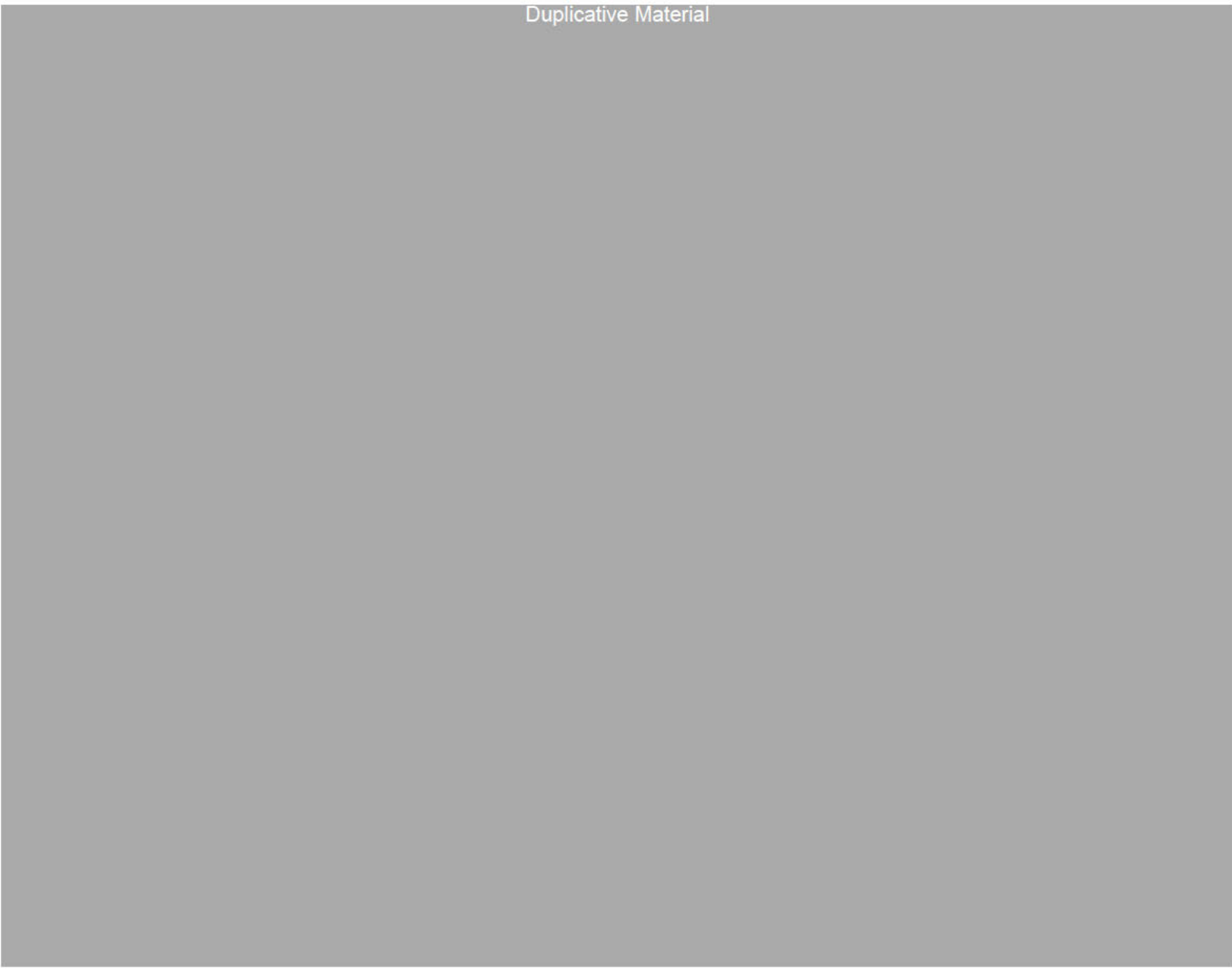

Ed,

As you and I discussed, the Adani case merits dismissal (certainly pursuant to POTUS Executive Order and AG's Memo on FCPA cases) not just based upon it being a bad case that would never be brought and it being Biden "trophy hunting" and atrocious decision-making by EDNY USA Breon Peace, but additionally for foreign relations and national security interests.
