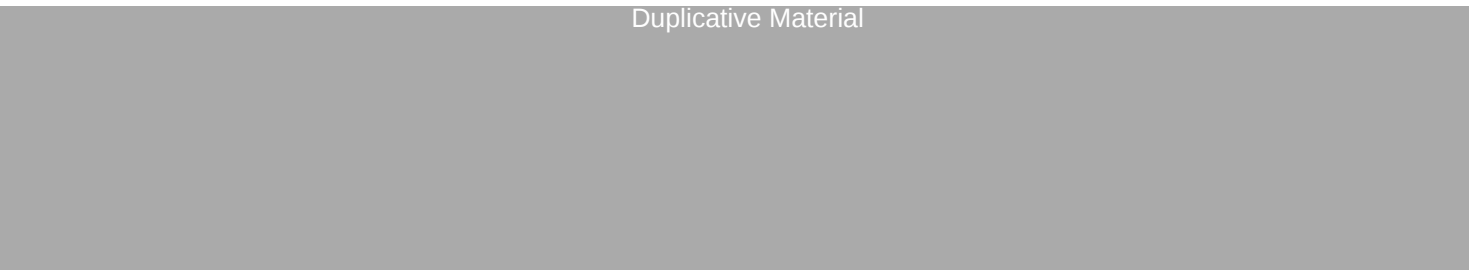

USDA had a similar issue recently when they faced a torrent of negative press following their funding cuts, which included food banks and similar programs. The prospect of bad stories shouldn't necessarily drive our policy decision-making process, but I think we all have a shared interest in avoiding them when we can.

4. The amount of disallowed costs in dispute, if any;
5. Any other relevant materials.

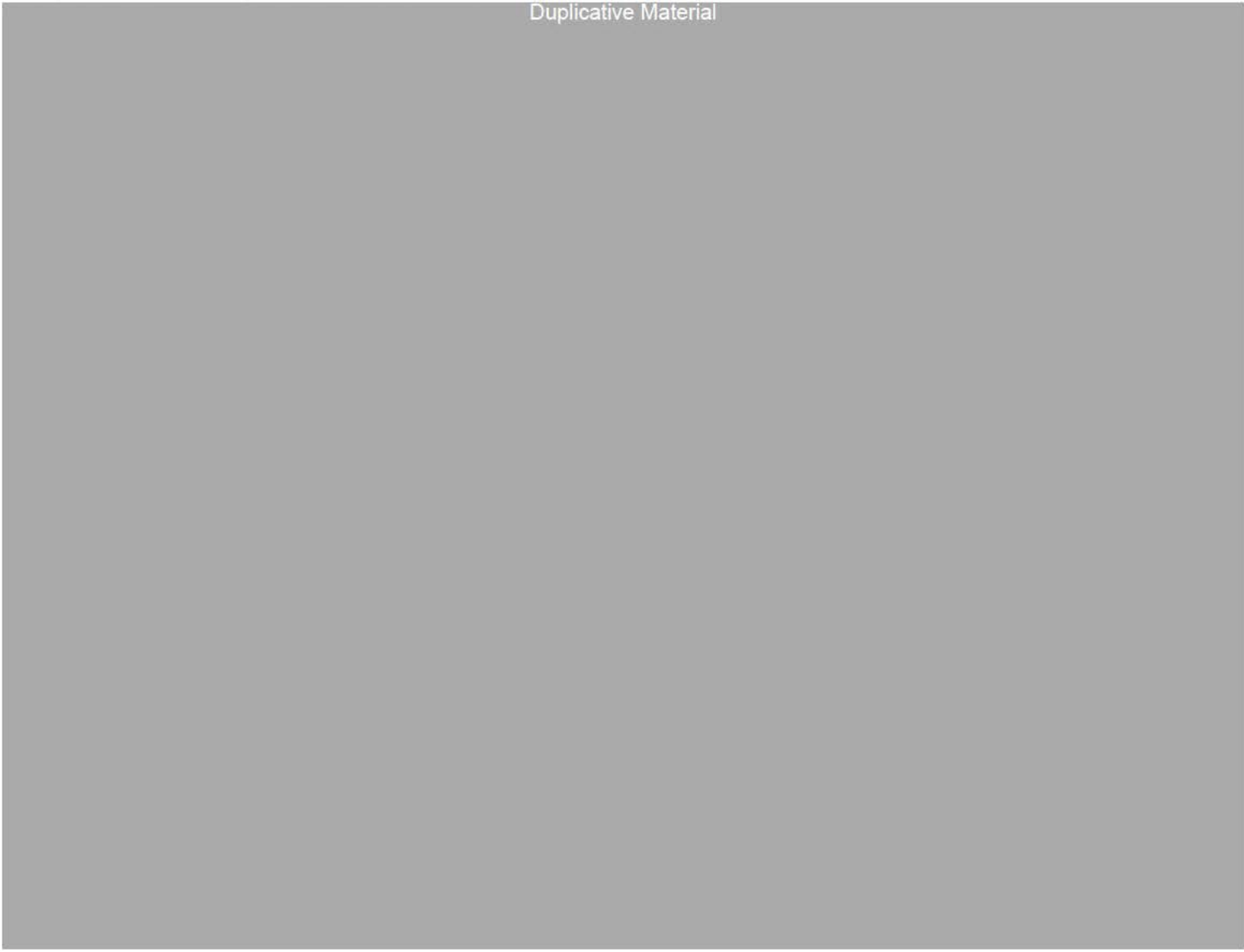

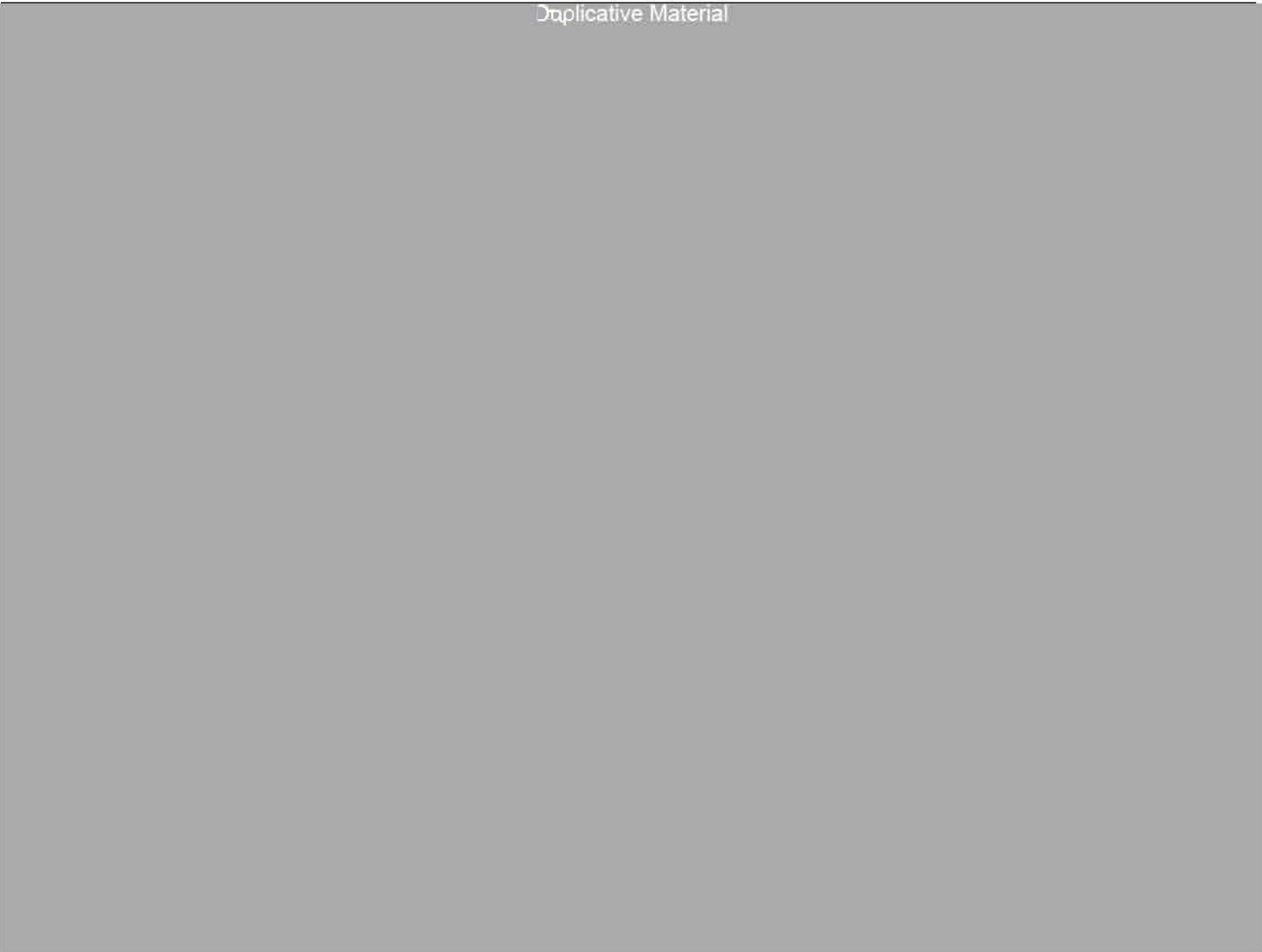
