That on or about April 27, 2018, within the Southern District of California, defendant, Eric Omar OROMAN-Contreras, an alien, did knowingly and willfully enter the United States at a time and place other than as designated by Immigration Officers, and elude examination and inspection by Immigration Officers, a misdemeanor; in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1325.

CONTINUATION OF COMPLAINT: Eric Omar OROMAN-Contreras

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

I declare under the penalty of perjury that the following statement is true and correct:

On April 27, 2018, Acting Supervisory Border Patrol Agent J. Renteria, was performing his assigned duties in the Imperial Beach Border Patrol Station's area of responsibility. At approximately 8:00 PM, Remote Video Surveillance System operator, Border Patrol Agent T. Cushing, advised he had observed two subjects climbing over the secondary fence in an area known to Border Patrol agents as "W-8." Agent Renteria responded to the area and encountered two subjects laying still on the ground in an attempt to stay out of view. This area is approximately two miles west of the San Ysidro, California Port of Entry and approximately 100 yards north of the United States/Mexico International Boundary. Agent Renteria approached the subjects in full rough duty uniform and conducted an immigration inspection. One subject admitted to being a citizen of Mexico without any immigration documents allowing him to enter or remain in the United States legally. The second subject, later identified as the defendant, Eric Omar OROMAN-Contreras, admitted to being a citizen of Guatemala without possession of immigration documents allowing him to enter or remain in the United States legally. At approximately 8:05 PM, Agent Renteria placed both subjects, including OROMAN under arrest. During administrative processing, OROMAN stated that he entered the United States on April 27, 2018.
