JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION

It is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

Defendant Paul Jean, individually and doing business as Whiz Tax, LLC, and Rejoice Services & Tax, Inc., and any other person working in concert or participation with him directly or indirectly, is PERMANENTLY ENJOINED from directly or indirectly preparing, assisting in the preparation of, or directing the preparation of federal tax returns, amended returns, claims for refund, or other tax-related documents and forms, including any electronically-submitted tax returns or tax-related documents, for any entity or person other than himself, pursuant to 26 U.S.C. §§ 7402(a) and 7407;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jean shall:

- 1) Produce to counsel for the United States within 30 days a list that identifies by name, social security number, address, e-mail address, telephone number, and tax period(s) all persons for whom he prepared federal income tax returns or claims for refund since January 1, 2015;

2) Notify within 30 days all persons for whom he prepared a federal tax return since January 1, 2015, to inform them of the permanent injunction entered against him; and


3) Produce to counsel for the United States a sworn certificate stating that he has complied with the affirmative requirements set forth above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the IRS is authorized to immediately revoke any Preparer Tax Identification Number (PTIN) that is held by, assigned to, or used by Jean, pursuant to 26 U.S.C. § 6109, and that the IRS is authorized to immediately revoke any Electronic Filing Identification Number (EFIN) held by, assigned to, or used by Jean;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States will be allowed full post-judgment discovery to monitor compliance with the permanent injunction; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court will retain jurisdiction over this action for purpose of implementing and enforcing the permanent injunction and any additional orders necessary and appropriate to the public interest.
