The United States Attorney charges:

In or about May 2015, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, and elsewhere, defendant CLIFFORD WOODS caused the introduction into interstate commerce of Taheebo Life Tea, Concentrated Extract, a new drug, as defined in Title 21, United States Code, Section 321(p), promoted as a treatment for cancer, that had not been approved through a new drug application filed pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 355(b) or (j), by causing, from his

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business location in Van Nuys, California, the shipment of a package of such product from Idaho to Washington, D.C.

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
