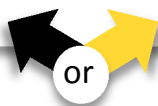

## BE ALERT

You may receive a stream of letters in your mailbox promising:



Wealth



Good Fortune

The letters may *appear* personalized but are actually identical, mass produced form-letters sent to thousands of recipients every month.

## TAKE ACTION

### Do Not Send Money

Consumers are never required to pay money to receive lottery or sweepstakes winnings.

### File a Complaint
