**INDICTMENT** 

The Grand Jury charges that:

#### COUNT 1

#### (Conspiracy to Possess with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

From on or about February 20, 2014, through on or about July 15, 2015, in Palm Beach

and Broward Counties, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

## CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU, KARL EDWARD VAETH, SALVATORE IEMOLO, GERALD ANTHONY MONTESORRENTINO, NICHOLAS CIRNIGLIARO, CHRISTOPHER LEE RODGERS, ALAN LEE ROSS, SHANE SHAHRAM ESLAHI, and

#### EDWARD JACK O'DONNELL, JR.,

did knowingly and willfully combine, conspire, confederate, and agree with each other and persons known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to possess with intent to distribute, and distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1); all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1); all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

With respect to the defendants, CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU, KARL EDWARD VAETH, SALVATORE IEMOLO, GERALD ANTHONY MONTESORRENTINO, SHANE SHAHRAM ESLAHI, NICHOLAS CIRNIGLIARO, CHRISTOPHER LEE RODGERS, ALAN LEE ROSS, SHANE SHAHRAM ESLAHI and EDWARD JACK O'DONNELL, JR., the controlled substance involved in the conspiracy attributable to them as a result of their own conduct, and the conduct of other conspirators reasonably foreseeable to them, is a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i).

#### COUNT 2

#### (Distribution of Anabolic Steroids)

On or about February 20, 2014, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

#### CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU,

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that

this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

## COUNT 3

## (Distribution of Anabolic Steroids)

On or about November 21, 2014, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

#### CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU,

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### COUNT 4

#### (Distribution of Anabolic Steroids)

On or about December 17, 2014, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

#### CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU,

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

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#### COUNT 5

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about March 5, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

### CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU and ALAN LEE ROSS,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### COUNT 6

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about March 10, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

# CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU and NICHOLAS CIRNIGLIARO,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic

steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### COUNT 7

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about March 11, 2015, in Palm Beach and Broward Counties, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

# CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU and CHRISTOPHER LEE RODGERS,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### COUNT 8

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about March 30, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

## CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU and SHANE SHAHRAM ESLAHI,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

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#### COUNT 9

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about March 31, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

# CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU and EDWARD JACK O'DONNELL, JR.,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

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#### COUNT 10

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about June 20, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

## KARL EDWARD VAETH and GERALD ANTHONY MONTESORRENTINO,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic

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steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### <u>COUNT 11</u>

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about July 1, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

# CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU, KARL EDWARD VAETH and SALVATORE IEMOLO,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### <u>COUNT 12</u>

#### (Possession with Intent to Distribute Anabolic Steroids)

On or about July 6, 2015, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendants,

### CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU and KARL EDWARD VAETH,

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

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Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### <u>COUNT 13</u>

#### (Distribution of Anabolic Steroids)

On or about March 30, 2016, in Palm Beach County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

#### GERALD ANTHONY MONTESORRENTINO,

did knowingly and intentionally distribute a controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1).

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(E)(i), it is further alleged that this violation involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of anabolic steroids, a Schedule III controlled substance.

#### CRIMINAL FORFEITURE

Upon conviction of any of the violations alleged in Counts 1 through 13 of this indictment, the defendants, CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU, KARL EDWARD VAETH, SALVATORE IEMOLO, GERALD ANTHONY MONTESORRENTINO, NICHOLAS CIRNIGLIARO, CHRISTOPHER LEE RODGERS, ALAN LEE ROSS, SHANE SHAHRAM ESLAHI and EDWARD JACK O'DONNELL, JR., shall forfeit to the United States any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds which the defendants CHRISTOPHER SHAUN COUSINEAU, KARL EDWARD VAETH, SALVATORE IEMOLO, GERALD ANTHONY MONTESORRENTINO, NICHOLAS CIRNIGLIARO, **CHRISTOPHER LEE RODGERS, ALAN LEE ROSS, SHANE SHAHRAM ESLAHI and EDWARD JACK O'DONNELL, JR.**, obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said violation and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit or facilitate the commission of such violation.
