**ORDER**

Upon the consent motion of the United States of America and the defendants Marc Baier, Ryan Adams, and Daniel Gericke (collectively, “Defendants”), for exclusion of time under the Speedy Trial Act, and finding in accordance with: (1) 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(2) in that prosecution is deferred by the attorney for the Government pursuant to written agreement with the Defendants, with the approval of the court, for the purpose of allowing the Defendants to demonstrate their good conduct; and (2) 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A) that the ends of justice in granting the extension of the speedy trial deadline outweigh the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial,

It is hereby ORDERED that all further criminal proceedings in this matter, including trial, be continued until further motion of the parties; and

It is further ORDERED that this Court approves the exclusion from the computation of time in which a trial must be commenced under the Speedy Trial Act, a period of 3.5 years from the date on which the Information was filed.
