THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

18 U.S.C. § 242  
(Deprivation of Rights Under Color of Law)

That on or about June 25, 2013, in the District of Kansas, the defendant,

JAMES CARSON,

while acting under color of law as a Trooper with the Kansas Highway Patrol, willfully deprived R.T. of the right, secured and protected by the Constitution and laws of the United

States, not to be deprived of liberty without due process of law, which includes the right to be free from the use of excessive force amounting to punishment by a law enforcement officer; specifically, the Defendant physically assaulted R.T., resulting in bodily injury to R.T.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 242.
