

**RENEWAL COMPUTER MATCHING AGREEMENT BETWEEN**  
**THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE**  
**AND**  
**THE DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY, INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE**  
**FOR**  
**THE TAXPAYER ADDRESS REQUEST PROGRAM**

Under the applicable provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974, amended by the Computer Matching and Privacy Protection Act of 1988, 5 U.S.C. Section 552a(o)(2), a computer matching agreement (CMA) will remain in effect for a period not to exceed 18 months. Within 3 months prior to the expiration of such CMA, however, the Data Integrity Board (DIB) may, without additional review, renew the CMA for a current, ongoing matching program for a period not to exceed 12 additional months if:

1. such program will be conducted without any changes; and
2. each party to the agreement certifies to the DIB in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the agreement.

The parties to this agreement hereby certify that the following match meets the conditions for renewal:

**I. TITLE OF MATCH**

Taxpayer Address Request (TAR) Program

**II. PARTIES TO THE MATCH**

Source Agency: Internal Revenue Service (IRS)  
Recipient Agency: Department of Justice (DOJ)

**III. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this agreement is to set forth the terms, conditions, and safeguards under which IRS agrees under the authority of 26 U.S.C. Section 6103(m)(2) to disclose taxpayer mailing addresses, upon written request, to the DOJ for use by officers, employees, or agents of the DOJ for the purpose of locating such taxpayer to collect or compromise a federal claim against the taxpayer in accordance with title 31 of U.S.C. Section 3711, 3717, and 3718. These statutes authorize DOJ to collect delinquent debts owed to the United States Government through litigation.
