A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON

FOR HER CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas on an information (Docket No. 4:06CR00068-002) charging violation of Section 371, Title 18, United States Code, for which she was sentenced on January 10, 2007, to 13 months' imprisonment, three years' supervised release, a \$1,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower the Acting Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to sign a grant of clemency to the person named herein. The Acting Pardon Attorney shall declare that her action is the act of the President, being performed at my direction.
