

Executive Grant of Clemency

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS **CHRIS YOUNG**, Reg. No. 20479-075, pleaded guilty in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee on an indictment (Docket No. 3:11CR00012-027) to violation of Section 2 (mistakenly omitted from the judgment), Title 18, and Section 846, Title 21, United States Code, for which a total sentence of 168 months' imprisonment, five years' supervised release, and a special assessment of \$100 was imposed on August 27, 2014, as amended on September 12, 2014 and September 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS the said **CHRIS YOUNG** has been confined continuously since his arrest on December 10, 2010, and is presently incarcerated at the United States Penitentiary—Beaumont in Beaumont, Texas; and

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that the ends of justice do not require the said **CHRIS YOUNG** to remain confined until his currently projected release date of November 14, 2022, and the safety of the community will not be compromised if he is released;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that I, **DONALD J. TRUMP**, President of the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, divers other good and sufficient reasons me thereunto moving, do hereby grant clemency to the said **CHRIS YOUNG**: I commute the 168-month prison sentence imposed upon the said **CHRIS YOUNG** to time served. I leave intact and in effect the remaining five-year term of supervised release with all its conditions, and all other components of the sentence.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower, the Office of the Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to deliver to the Bureau of Prisons, to the United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee, and to the said **CHRIS YOUNG** a certified copy of this document as evidence of my action in order to carry into effect the terms of this grant.

I ALSO DIRECT the Bureau of Prisons, upon receipt of this warrant, to effect the immediate release of the said **CHRIS YOUNG** with all possible speed.
