Army Soldier Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

(Newport News, Virginia) - Clint Manuel McVey, age 28, of Lynchburg, Virginia, was indicted by a federal grand jury on 36 counts related to child pornography yesterday. McVey, who is assigned to a Transportation Company in the United States Army, Fort Eustis in Newport News, Virginia, was charged with receipt and possession of child pornography in violation of federal law. McVey was arrested without incident today at Fort Eustis by Special Agents of the Department of the Army, Criminal Investigative Command, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). Chuck Rosenberg, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia, made the announcement, after McVey's arrest.

McVey is scheduled to appear in Federal court in Norfolk for an initial appearance today at 3pm.

The United States Attorney's Office is prosecuting the case in conjunction with the Virginia State Attorney General's Office. The case was investigated by the Department of the Army, Criminal Investigative Command and the FBI, Peninsula Resident Agency Office. Assistant United States Attorney, Lisa McKeel will be prosecuting the case for the United States.

A defendant is presumed to be innocent until and unless proven guilty.
