Fee. MS shall pay UUNET PIPEX a fee (the "Fee") of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (US\$500,000). MS shall pay the Fee to UUNET PIPEX in two tranches. The first tranche of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) shall be paid by MS to UUNET PIPEX at such time as UUNET PIPEX fulfills its obligations in accordance with the provisions of Exhibit C and has implemented the features specified in sections 1 and 2 of Exhibit D. The second tranche of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) shall be paid by MS to UUNET PIPEX nine (9) months after the date of payment of the first tranche, provided that UUNET PIPEX is still fulfilling its obligations in Exhibit C and has implemented, and has maintained implemented, the features specified in sections 1 and 2 of Exhibit D, unless otherwise agreed in writing between the parties.
