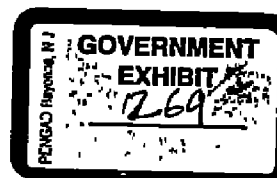
You have a great product Phil and I am sure we can find a home for it. Stay in touch and hope to see you in the future.
