I am writing about Monsanto and the general concern of GMO seeds being controlled in a monopolized fashion. There exists extremely diverse variations of food crops and seeds, and yet Monsanto's patenting and control over seeds and their emphasis on specific crops threatens to destabilize the natural diversity. It is completely inappropriate that such an entity could be in such a situation to have this degree of impact.

Please keep seeds freely marketed and ideally public-domain. It is simply too risky to allow such a powerful private entity to control the basis of our food supply.
