My name is Paula Crow. I am a citizen of Salt Lake City, gardner and food co-op member. I am concerned by the consolidation of our food supply to large corporate conglomerates.

Concerns of mine include the loss of livelihood for small farmers, the treatment of animals in factory farms, the use of antibiotics to keep animals from contracting diseases in unsafe living environments and the subsequent effects on the consumer, the increased likelihood of disease spreading faster and further through a consolidated food system. I am particularly concerned by hybrid crops and terminator seeds, specifically corporate control of the genetics of seed stock.
