The mission of the **Antitrust Division** is to protect consumers by promoting economic competition through enforcing and providing guidance on antitrust laws and principles.

The goal of the antitrust laws is to protect economic freedom and opportunity by promoting free and fair competition in the marketplace. The **Antitrust Division** prosecutes certain violations of the antitrust laws by filing criminal charges that can lead to large fines and jail sentences.



In other cases, the **Antitrust Division** institutes civil actions seeking court orders forbidding future violations of the law and requiring steps to remedy the anticompetitive effects of past violations. These actions may challenge mergers or conduct that violates the antitrust laws.
