
**ORDER GRANTING THE UNITED STATES**

**VICTIM NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES**

The United States having moved the Court for an order permitting an alternative means for notification of victims in this case pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3771(d)(2), and the Court having considered said motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, it is hereby ordered and adjudged that the motion be, and the same hereby is, sustained.

After an initial mailing as described in the government's motion for alternative victim notification procedures, all future notifications to victims of information required by the Crime Victims' Rights Act may be by the use of the Victim Notification System (VNS) and may be

delivered by either the VNS Call Center, the VNS Internet site, and the United States Attorney's Office website and toll free phone number.
