The Grand Jury charges that:

**Counts 1-5  
Theft of Mail  
(18 U.S.C. § 1708)**

On or about October 14, 2014, in Indianapolis, Indiana, within the Southern District of Indiana, the defendant, BRYON FISHER, did steal, take, and abstract, and attempted to steal, take, and abstract, from and out of an authorized depository for mail matter, that is, a post office box located within a United States Post Office located at 125 West South Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46206, mail items addressed as follows:

Each of which is a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1708.


