THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

(49 U.S.C. §§ 32703(2) and 32709(b) - Odometer Tampering)


1. At times relevant and material to this Information, defendant NORMAN LEE GRIFFIN purchased and sold motor vehicles in College Station, Texas, and elsewhere, using the name Mr. G's Toy Store to purchase and sell vehicles.

2. On or about January 15, 2005, in the Southern District of Texas, NORMAN LEE GRIFFIN, defendant herein, did knowingly and willfully reset and alter, and cause to be reset and altered, the odometer of a 1995 Chevrolet K1500 with Vehicle Identification Number 1GCEK14KXSZ239023, with the intent to change the number of miles indicated on the odometer, from approximately 149,502 to approximately 89,700.


In violation of Title 49, United States Code, Sections 32703(2) and 32709(b), and Title
