Agency and Governing Body Signatures

The Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification report must be filed by participating agencies each year, regardless of whether equitable sharing funds were received. This form requires the signature of both the head of the agency and the governing body, or his or her designee. The governing body is the agency that allocates appropriated funding to your agency. **The governing body head cannot be from within the law enforcement agency.** The governing body signature affirms that the agency's appropriated budget has not been reduced as a result of receiving equitably shared funds. The law enforcement agency head directs and approves all equitable sharing fund expenditures pursuant to all jurisdictional procurement requirements.
