THE DEFENDANT: was found guilty following trial on counts 1-16 of the superseding indictment.

Accordingly the defendant is adjudicated guilty of the following offenses:

The following sentence is imposed pursuant to the Sentencing Reform Act of 1984.

## IMPRISONMENT

The defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the United States Bureau of Prisons to be imprisoned for a total of 24 months on each count of conviction; all such sentences are concurrent.

# SUPERVISED RELEASE

Upon release from imprisonment, the defendant shall be on supervised release for a total term of **2** years. The Mandatory and Standard Conditions of Supervised Release as attached, are imposed. In addition, the following Special Condition is imposed:

1. The defendant is prohibited from possessing a firearm or other dangerous weapon.

This is a non-guidelines sentence based principally on the defendant's extraordinary charitable contributions, his exceptional character, and the lack of motivation of direct personal gain from his criminal conduct. In addition, the goals of specific and general deterrence are satisfied, as well as the other factors set forth in 18 U.S.C. §3553(a).

#### **CRIMINAL MONETARY PENALTIES**

The defendant must pay the total criminal monetary penalties under the schedule of payments as follows.

Special Assessment: \$ 1,600.00 Fine: \$200,000.00

It is further ordered that the defendant will notify the United States Attorney for this district within 30 days of any change of name, residence or mailing address until all fines and special assessments imposed by this judgment, are paid.

## **FORFEITURE**

A final order of forfeiture accompanies, and is made a part of, this Judgment.

## JUDICIAL RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE BUREAU OF PRISONS

The defendant shall be designated to the Satellite Prison Camp, Otisville, New York ("SPC Otisville"), based on his age, his need to be in proximity to his family, and the resources of that facility.

The defendant shall self surrender to the facility designated by the U. S. Bureau of Prisons or to the United States Marshal for the District of Connecticut on February 18, 2009.
