**ORDER GRANTING UNITED STATES' MOTION TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO VICTIMS BY PUBLICATION**


Upon unopposed application of the United States of America, the Court finds that (1) the United States has already provided individual notice to approximately 37,000 potential victims identified as part of a prior civil action against CSK Auto Corp.; (2) to the extent additional potential victims exist, it would be impracticable to provide individual notice to those victims as contemplated in the Justice for All Act (“the Act”) at 18 U.S.C. § 3771(a)(2); (3) accordingly, the “multiple crime victims” provision of the Act applies to this case; and, (4) the means of notifying potential victims as set forth in the United States’ Motion to Provide Notice to Victims by Publication constitutes a “reasonable procedure” to give effect to the notice provisions of the Act.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED granting Government’s Motion to Provide Notice to Victims by Publication [doc. 84].

Accordingly, the United States is authorized to comply with 18 U.S.C. § 3771(a)(2) by giving notice to potential victims in this case by posting a notice in the *Wall Street Journal*, and

1 by posting information relevant to the notification of victims on the website for the Department  
2 of Justice, located at <http://www.ojp.usdoj.gov/ovc> an ongoing basis throughout the court  
3 proceedings.
