**ORDER**

\_\_\_\_\_ Having considered the United States’ Unopposed Motion for an Order Authorizing Alternative Victim Notification, the Court finds that: (1) there are tens of thousands of potential victims throughout the world, some of whom have not yet been identified by the United States and for whom the United States has no readily available contact information; (2) it is impractical to individually provide each potential victim all of the rights enumerated in Section 3771(a) of the Act; (3) the “multiple crime victims” provision of the Act applies to this case; and (4) the means of notifying potential victims as set forth in the Motion constitutes a “reasonable


procedure” to give effect to and ensure compliance with the notice provisions of the Act.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Government is authorized to comply with 18 U.S.C. 3771(a)(2) and give notice to potential victims in this case by:

(1) Posting information about the case and notice of court proceedings on the Department of Justice’s website, located at <http://www.usdoj.gov/criminal/vns/> and by giving written notice to Ralph S. Janvey, Esq., of Krage & Janvey, the Court-appointed receiver in the civil injunctive action filed by the United States Securities and Exchange Commission, who will, in turn, include on the receivership’s website, <http://www.stanfordfinancialreceivership.com/>, postings for potential victims seeking information about this criminal case and any related criminal cases.
