13,877 A#s in the ICE data were not matched up with any records of the EOIR cases selected for analysis.

Of the 8,306 cases, we excluded 369 never-detained cases, so the total number of cases in comparison is **7,937**.

Of the 9,503 cases, 3,199 were never-detained cases, so the number of cases for individuals originally detained was **6,304**.

Court transfer status of the 6,304 cases:

COV in 1,161 started out of NY crt and transferred to NY crt
COV out 82 started in NY crt and transferred out
Other 14 started out of NY crt, back in NY crt, and transferred out again
Stayed 5,047 started and latest hearing in NY crt (could be transfers in btw)

Notes about case selection:

We received 31,341 unique A#s from ICE. We matched them with the EOIR data which include 71,767 cases with hearings in NY court and cases heard in other courts across the nation. These 71,767 cases involved 71,433 unique A#s. Due to the fact that one person can have multiple cases, it makes sense to use cases instead of unique persons. In addition, most people only had one case. As a result, 8,306 cases without any hearings in NY court and 9,503 cases with hearings in NY court in EOIR data were matched up with ICE A#s. Since our purpose is to see whether transferring out of NY has any impact on detained cases, we excluded never-detained cases from these two groups. Therefore, 7,937 cases without any hearings in NY court (i.e., cases for persons arrested and transferred out of NY by ICE and never COV to NY court) and 6,304 cases with hearings in NY were included in our analysis.

The statistics derived from EOIR and ICE data were compiled and analyzed by the Vera Institute of Justice. They do not constitute official statistics of either EOIR or ICE.
