Ukraine: Whether a person who has left Ukraine and arrived in Canada using false documents can acquire a Ukrainian international passport from a Ukrainian consulate in Canada using a birth certificate; documents needed to obtain an international passport from a consulate in Canada (January 2005 - August 2005)

Neither information on whether a person who has used false documents can acquire a Ukrainian passport from a consulate in Canada using a birth certificate nor information on the documents needed to obtain a passport from a Ukrainian consulate could be found among the sources consulted by the Research Directorate within time constraints.
