PROPOSED DECISION

This is a claim against the Government of Czechoslovakia under Section 404, Title IV, of the International Claims Settlement Act of 1949, as amended, by MARGARET WOLF. The claim is based upon an amount said to be due from the firm Weiss & Hanak in Brno, Czechoslovakia.

The Commission has concluded for the reasons stated in the attached copy of Proposed Decision No. CZ-734, In the Matter of the Claim of Skins Trading Corporation, Claim No. CZ-3978, that claims based upon unsecured debts due from Czechoslovakian concerns are not compensable under Section 404 of the Act. Accordingly, this claim is denied.

The Commission finds it unnecessary to make determinations with respect to other elements of the claim.
