SUPPLEMENTAL FINAL DECISION

The Commission issued its Proposed Decision on this claim on May 23, 1962, entering an award based upon the taking of the claimant's interest in certain patents. Thereafter, and following the filing and consideration of objections to the said Proposed Decision, the Commission issued its Final Decision on this claim dated August 1, 1962.

Subsequent to the entry of the Final Decision the claimant submitted certain additional information. Upon review and consideration of such additional information, the Commission now finds the value of the claimant's interest in the patents was \$3,948.25 and that an additional award in the amount of \$1,191.00 should issue.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the following supplemental award be entered:

A W A R D

A supplemental award is hereby made to E. I. DU PONT DE NEMOURS & COMPANY in the principal amount of One Thousand One Hundred and Ninety-one Dollars (\$1,191.00) plus interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from February 28, 1948 to August 8, 1958, the

effective date of Title IV of the Act, in the amount of Six Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$674.90) for a total supplemental award in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$1,865.90);
and it is further

ORDERED that this supplemental award be certified to the
Secretary of the Treasury.
