Seventy-Four Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$674.90) for a total supplemental award in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$1,865.90);

ORDERED that this supplemental award be certified to the Secretary of the Treasury.
