



FINAL DECISION

PROPOSED DECISION

This claim is by Christian Hegel and Magdalena Hegel, both nationals of the United States since January 22, 1925 and January 4, 1927, respectively, the dates on which they were naturalized by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York, and is for compensation in the amount of \$21,176.47 plus interest, for the taking by the Government of Yugoslavia of various items of personal property and for real property recorded under Docket No. 3402 of the Cadastral District of Sekic and Dockets Nos. 5699, 1995, 2191 and 3764 of the Cadastral Districts of Backa Petrovo and Selo, Yugoslavia.

As evidence of ownership of the land, the Government of Yugoslavia filed certified extracts from the Land Registers of the District Courts of Becej and Backa Topola. Those extracts show, and the Government of Yugoslavia admits claimants' ownership, in equal shares, of the following property:
