Aug. 2, 2001 — Committee Vote: Office of Government Ethics Reauthorization — En bloc Reauthorizes funds for the Office of Government Ethics, an executive branch office that prevents and resolves conflicts of interests involving government employees, through fiscal 2006. The office was created under the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (PL 95-521) Reported favorably to

the full Senate by voice vote.
