I hope you're doing well. As we discussed last week, in addition to the Johnson County Sheriff's Office, the Des Moines County Sheriff's Office was also slated to have their COPS Law Enforcement Technology Grant transferred to the Office of Justice Programs. Since OJP appears to have subsequently declined to take on any grant transfers, Congressman Loeb sack would very much appreciate efforts by the COPS Office to fund the equipment that he intended for the grant money to cover for the Des Moines County Sheriff. This equipment includes:

- Tactical Ballistic Vests and accessories
- Ballistic Helmets
- Ballistic Shields
- Tactical lighting equipment
- Tactical holsters
- Goggles
- Tactical comms for existing radios
- Night Vision
- Less lethal munitions
- Training equipment - simmunitions for AR-15

It was this equipment that Congressman Loeb sack considered critical for the Des Moines County Sheriff and for which he intended the grant money to go toward. Any assistance the COPS Office can provide in funding this essential equipment for the Sheriff would be greatly appreciated by the Congressman.
